Subject: Diversion of 9.1904 ha of forest land in Thally Reserve Forest of Jawalagiri Range Hosur Division for laying of 765 KV S/C transmission line between Dharmapuri (Salem) Madhugiri in favour of Chief Manager, Nagapattinam - Madhugiri Transmission Company Ltd, subsidiary of Power Grid Corporation of India Ltd., Bangalore-reg

Sir,

Please refer to the State Government's letter No.25060/FR.10/2013-1 dated 20.12.2013 & PCCF, Tamil Nadu letters No. 37867/2013/TS3 dated 28.01.2015 & 27.02.2015 seeking prior approval of the Central Government in accordance with Section'2' of Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980 for the above mentioned project. The project was accorded in-principle approval (Stage-I) by the Central Government vide letter dated 23.08.2017. The PCCF of Tamil Nadu vide letter No. TS3/37867/2013 dated 17.07.2018 has reported compliance to the conditions stipulated in the in-principle approval.

After careful consideration of the proposal of the State Government, I am hereby directed to convey the Central Government's approval (Stage-II) under Section '2' of Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980 for diversion of 9.1904 ha of forest land in Thally Reserve Forest of Jawalagiri Range Hosur Division for laying of 765 KV S/C transmission line between Dharmapuri (Salem) Madhugiri in favour of Chief Manager, Nagapattinam - Madhugiri Transmission Company Ltd, subsidiary of Power Grid Corporation of India Ltd., Bangalore for a period of 20 years, subject to the following conditions:-

- 1. The legal status of forest land shall remain unchanged.
- 2. The State Forest Department shall carry out demarcation of the proposed forest area by erecting 4 feet high cement concrete pillars duly numbered at an interval of 20 meters from the amount which has already been realized from the user agency before execution of the work;

- 3. State Forest Department shall carry out Compensatory Afforestation (CA) and its maintenance over 20 ha. of degraded forest land identified in Jawalagiri Reserve Forest of Hosur Forest Division from the amount which has already been realized from the User Agency;
- 4. The approved CA land and CA scheme shall not be changed without prior permission of the Government of India;
- 5. Additional amount of Net Present Value (NPV) of the diverted forest land if any, becoming due after revision of the same by the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in future, shall be charged by the State Government from the User Agency;
- 6. The State Forest Department shall carry out plantation of dwarf species preferably medicinal plants in the Right of Way under the transmission line from the amount which has already been realized from the User Agency;
- 7. The State Government / DFO concerned shall abide by the conditions imposed by the NBWL and ensure that the mitigation measures suggested shall be complied with by the user agency and State Forest Department shall carry out mitigation measures for wildlife conservation from the amount which has already been realized from the user agency;
- 8. The height of the transmission line shall be raised by additional 6 meters compared to normal level;
- 9. The State Forest Department shall carry out translocation of the trees wherever feasible at the cost of User Agency;
- 10. The forest land proposed for diversion shall under no circumstances be transferred or sublet to any other agency, department or person without prior approval of the Central Government;
- 11. The layout plan of the proposal shall not be changed without the prior approval of the Central Government. User Agency shall furnish an undertaking to this effect;
- 12. The user agency shall provide fire wood preferably alternate fuel to labourers working at the site to avoid damage/tree felling;
- 13. User agency shall ensure that the labourers, staff engaged in construction activity do not damage nearby forest flora and fauna;

- 14. User Agency shall bear the cost every year for special protection of the forest blocks through which the line is passing, as per the assessment of DFO, Hosur Forest Division;
- 15. Felling of trees other than 196 trees of spontaneous origin for which permission has been obtained for felling from the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India shall not be carried out;
- 16. The User Agency and the State Government shall ensure compliance to Ministry's guidelines F.No 7-25/2012-FC dated 5th May, 2014 and provisions of the all Acts, Rules, Regulation and Guidelines of the Ministry, for the time being in force, as applicable to the transmission line projects.
- 17. The total forest area utilized for the project shall not exceed 9.1904 ha and the forest area diverted shall not be used for any purpose other than those shown in the diversion proposal;
- 18. The Progress of the Compensatory Afforestation as mentioned by the DFO, Hosur Division in SI No 12 (v) (a) of part II i.e 56.34 ha of forest land shall be monitored by the Circle Head and a copy of such monitoring report shall be forwarded to the Regional Office.
- 19. Any other conditions that the Central Government or Addl. PCCF(Central) of Regional Office, Chennai may impose from time to time in the interest of afforestation, conservation and management of flora and fauna in the area, shall be complied by the user agency
- 20. The user agency shall submit the annual self compliance report in respect of the above conditions to the State Govt. and to the Regional Office, regularly.
- 21. In the event of failure to comply with any of the above conditions the user agency is liable for penal action as decided by the Additional PCCF (Central), Regional Office, Chennai.
