Subject: Debarment i.e. exclusion of Techno Global Services Pvt. Ltd (TECHNO GLOBAL) from participating as Bidder or Sub-contractor in tenders/Contracts and from award of contracts by Power Grid Corporation of India Ltd. (POWERGRID)

Dear Sir,

- 1.0 WHEREAS Power Grid Corporation of India Ltd (hereinafter referred to as "POWERGRID"), is a company incorporated under the Companies Act, 1956 having its registered office at B-9, Qutab Institutional Area, Katwaria Sarai, New Delhi-110016.
- 2.0 WHEREAS, POWERGRID had invited bids for Package DC-1 for Construction & Interiors of Green Field Data Centre Building at Manesar under Establishment of Pilot Data Centre at POWERGRID Manesar substation vide IFB dtd. 30/06/2022.
- 3.0 WHEREAS, you have submitted the bid for aforesaid Package and first Envelope of your bid was opened on 15/09/2022.
- 4.0 WHEREAS, in the bid for subject Package, you have inter-alia submitted documents viz. (i) Attachment-8: Manufacturer Authorization; (ii) Attachment-22: Certificate from auditor; (iii) Attachment-24: Affidavit of self-certification regarding domestic value addition in Iron & Steel Products) and (iv) Attachment-27: Certification by the Bidder per order no. F.No.6/18/2019-PPD dated 23/07/2020 issued by Public Procurement Division, Department of Expenditure, Ministry of Finance, Government of India (DoE Order) in line with ITB 2.1.
- 5.0 WHEREAS, another bidder namely M/s ANS Construction Pvt. Ltd. (ANS), in their bid have inter-alia submitted (i) Attachment-8: Manufacturer Authorization; (ii) Attachment-24: Affidavit of self-certification regarding domestic value addition in Iron & Steel Products) and (iii) Attachment-27: Certification by the Bidder per order no. F.No.6/18/2019-PPD dated 23/07/2020 issued by Public Procurement Division, Department of Expenditure, Ministry of Finance, Government of India (DoE Order) in line with ITB 2.1.

6.0 WHEREAS certain observations were noticed in the aforesaid documents submitted by ANS and TECHNO GLOBAL in their respective bid as brought out hereunder:

- (i) In Attachment-8 submitted by you, name of ANS is mentioned. Further, the plant address mentioned by you and ANS in their respective Attachment-8 is same.
- (ii) In the Attachment-22 submitted by you, name of ANS is mentioned as supplier. The said Attachment has been signed/issued by you on behalf of auditor.
- (iii) In the Attachment-24 (affidavit regarding Iron & Steel policy) submitted by you, the details of PoA holder of ANS i.e. Mr. Manoj Kumar along with his residential address is mentioned. However, the same is signed by your PoA holder. Further, name of ANS is mentioned as name of bidder in the above attachment.
- (iv) In Attachment-27 submitted by you, name of ANS's PoA holder is mentioned.

The aforesaid documents raised serious concerns and reflect probable collusion between the parties.

7.0 WHEREAS, Clause 36 of ITB, Section-II, of the Bidding Documents for the package which is referred to at sl no 2.0 above, states that it is the Employer's policy that requires the Bidders, suppliers and contractors and their subcontractors under the contracts to observe the highest standard of ethics during the procurement and execution of such contracts.

8.0 WHEREAS, as per the terms of the Integrity Pact at Attachment 14-IP of the Bid form(First Envelope), Volume-III of the Bidding Documents for the package which is referred to at sl no 2.0 above, the Bidder inter-alia commits to take all measures necessary to prevent corruption during the contract execution inter-alia including a specific commitment that the Bidder will not enter into any illegal or undisclosed agreement or understanding, whether formal or informal with other bidders/Contractors in particular to prices, specifications, certifications, subsidiary contracts, submission or non-submission of bids or actions to restrict competitiveness or to introduce cartelisation in the bidding process [refer Section-II, para 1 (b)]

9.0 AND WHEREAS, as per the relevant clauses of ITB as brought out at sl no 7.0 above, in pursuance of its policy on Fraud and Corruption, Employer may sanction a firm or individual, including declaring ineligible for a stated period of time from award of contract if it at any time determines that the firm has, directly or through an agent, engaged in fraudulent, collusive practices in competing for a contract. Further, as per the terms of the Integrity Pact [refer Section-III], if the Bidder has committed a transgression through a violation of Section II such as to put his reliability or creditability into question, POWERGRID may, after following due procedure, ban/blacklist the contractor in line with POWERGRID's Policy for "Black-Listing of Firms / Banning of Business".

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- 10.0 AND WHEREAS, vide our letter dated 20/03/2023, a Show cause notice has been issued to you, thereby, giving you an opportunity to explain as to why action should not be taken against you in view of fraudulent/collusive practices as reflected from the documents submitted by the parties.
- 11.0 AND WHEREAS, POWERGRID has not received any reply from you against the Show Cause Notice issued on 20/03/2023. Therefore, it may be inferred that you have nothing further to submit in the matter.
- 12.0 NOW THEREFORE, it is hereby informed that without prejudice to any other rights available to POWERGRID in terms of the provisions of Bidding Documents/ Integrity Pact/Policy and Procedures of POWERGRID/or the applicable law, M/s. Techno Global Services Pvt. Ltd. is hereby debarred i.e. excluded from participating as Bidder or Sub-contractor in Tenders/Contracts and from award of Contracts by Power Grid Corporation of India Ltd. (POWERGRID) for a period of 01 year w.e.f. 09/12/2025 on the ground of violation of ITB Clause 36 and clause 1b) of Section-II of Integrity Pact of the Bidding Documents for the package referred to at sl no 2.0 above.
- 13.0 FURTHER, in case of ongoing contracts, if any, with POWERGRID, you are hereby warned to refrain from any transgression of the Integrity Pact/Contract provisions.
- 14.0 It may also be noted that the above is without prejudice to our other rights under the bidding documents and in law.
