 - d. Copy of EFT Mandate duly certified by Bank.
- 2. Buyer Organization specific Integrity Pact shall have to be complied by all bidders. Bidders shall have to upload scanned copy of signed integrity pact as per Buyer organizations policy along with bid. Click here to view the file
- 3. **Manufacturer Authorization:**Wherever Authorised Distributors/service providers are submitting the bid, Authorisation Form /Certificate with OEM/Original Service Provider details such as name, designation, address, e-mail Id and Phone No. required to be furnished along with the bid
- 4. Without prejudice to Buyer's right to price adjustment by way of discount or any other right or remedy available to Buyer, Buyer may terminate the Contract or any part thereof by a written notice to the Seller, if
 - i) The Seller fails to comply with any material term of the Contract.
 - ii) The Seller informs Buyer of its inability to deliver the Material(s) or any part thereof within the stipulated Delivery Period or such inability otherwise becomes apparent.
 - iii) The Seller fails to deliver the Material(s) or any part thereof within the stipulated Delivery Period and/or to replace/rectify any rejected or defective Material(s) promptly.
 - iv) The Seller becomes bankrupt or goes into liquidation.
 - v) The Seller makes a general assignment for the benefit of creditors.
 - vi) A receiver is appointed for any substantial property owned by the Seller.
 - vii) The Seller has misrepresented to Buyer, acting on which misrepresentation Buyer has placed the Purchase Order on the Seller.
- 5. Scope of supply (Bid price to include all cost components): Only supply of Goods

General	Scope Limited to Insulators only: This tender pertains exclusively to insulators, while the hardware is already installed on the transmission lines. As such, the make, condition, and technical details of the in-service hardware are neither available to us nor covered in the tender documents	Relevant Hardware Drawin gs shall be shared to succ essful bidder after award.

General	Drawings of Existing Hardware Not A vailable: No drawings or specifications of the installed hardware have been provide d in Tender. Without this information, it is not possible to assess interface compatibil ity or to ensure that the supplied insulator drawings align with the actual hardware in use.	
General	Insulators Issued from O&M Stores: T he replacement insulators are dispatched from O&M stores and may be used on any line depending on site requirements. Give n this situation, it is not practically feasible for us, as an insulator supplier, to ensure or certify field-level compatibility.	
General	EFM: The ability to validate EFM is entirel y dependent on the availability of actual in stallation drawings, including hardware co nfigurations. Without access to accurate a nd complete hardware drawings (e.g., end fittings, corona ring dimensions), it is not f easible to conduct an EFM study or confide ntly verify compliance with the provided E-field thresholds.	
General	765kV 160kN & 210kN calls for the type test wi th Hexa Zebra conductor whereas 765kV 1 20kN & 210 kN calls for type test with Qua d Bersimis. Therefore, we are unsure of the Qty requir ed for 210 KN with Quad Bersimis / Hexa Zebra for the project.	The insulators are require d for O&M purposes and a s such this information is not predetermined.

- 3. Publishing Custom / BOQ bids for items for which regular GeM categories are available without any Category item bunched with it.
- 4. Creating BoQ bid for single item.
- 5. Mentioning specific Brand or Make or Model or Manufacturer or Dealer name.
- 6. Mandating submission of documents in physical form as a pre-requisite to qualify bidders.
- 7. Floating / creation of work contracts as Custom Bids in Services.
- 8. Seeking sample with bid or approval of samples during bid evaluation process. (However, in bids for <u>attached categories</u>, trials are allowed as per approved procurement policy of the buyer nodal Ministries)
- 9. Mandating foreign / international certifications even in case of existence of Indian Standards without specifying equivalent Indian Certification / standards.
- 10. Seeking experience from specific organization / department / institute only or from foreign / export experience.
- 11. Creating bid for items from irrelevant categories.
- 12. Incorporating any clause against the MSME policy and Preference to Make in India Policy.
- 13. Reference of conditions published on any external site or reference to external documents/clauses.
- 14. Asking for any Tender fee / Bid Participation fee / Auction fee in case of Bids / Forward Auction, as the case may be.
- 15. Buyer added ATC Clauses which are in contravention of clauses defined by buyer in system generated bid template as indicated above in the Bid Details section, EMD Detail, ePBG Detail and MII and MSE Purchase Preference sections of the bid, unless otherwise allowed by GeM GTC.
