Buyer Added Bid Specific Additional Terms and Conditions

1. Bidders are advised to check applicable GST on their own before quoting. Buyer will not take any responsibility in this regards. GST reimbursement will be as per actuals or as per applicable rates (whichever is lower), subject to the maximum of quoted GST %.
2. Bidder shall submit the following documents along with their bid for Vendor Code Creation:
 - a. Copy of PAN Card.
 - b. Copy of GSTIN.
 - c. Copy of Cancelled Cheque.
 - d. Copy of EFT Mandate duly certified by Bank.
3. **Manufacturer Authorization:** Wherever Authorised Distributors/service providers are submitting the bid, Authorisation Form /Certificate with OEM/Original Service Provider details such as name, designation, address, e-mail Id and Phone No. required to be furnished along with the bid
4. Without prejudice to Buyer's right to price adjustment by way of discount or any other right or remedy available to Buyer, Buyer may terminate the Contract or any part thereof by a written notice to the Seller, if:
 - i) The Seller fails to comply with any material term of the Contract.
 - ii) The Seller informs Buyer of its inability to deliver the Material(s) or any part thereof within the stipulated Delivery Period or such inability otherwise becomes apparent.
 - iii) The Seller fails to deliver the Material(s) or any part thereof within the stipulated Delivery Period and/or to replace/rectify any rejected or defective Material(s) promptly.
 - iv) The Seller becomes bankrupt or goes into liquidation.
 - v) The Seller makes a general assignment for the benefit of creditors.
 - vi) A receiver is appointed for any substantial property owned by the Seller.
 - vii) The Seller has misrepresented to Buyer, acting on which misrepresentation Buyer has placed the Purchase Order on the Seller.

1.	General	Dispatch Locations: As per the BOQ, different head office addresses along with quantities are mentioned. Kindly confirm whether the helmets are required to be dispatched to all the mentioned locations individually or if dispatch to a single location will be sufficient. This clarification is important, as freight charges will vary based on the number of dispatch locations.	Smart safety helmets are required to be dispatched to all the mentioned locations individually as per the BOQ.
2.	General	Training & Demonstration Requirement: The BOQ mentions training and demonstration for site personnel on helmet usage and the software interface. Kindly clarify whether training and demonstration are required at all the respective head offices/sites, or if it would be acceptable to conduct the training at a single centralized location by gathering personnel from all sites. Please note that conducting training at multiple locations would have an impact on the overall pricing.	Physical training will be required to be conducted by the vendor at one of our Construction / O&M sites preferably near Gurgaon, while all remaining site personnel will join through a virtual medium.
3.	General	Please clarify that how many control rooms required to be setup to monitor audio and video from helmets.	The requirement includes a dispatcher for each device, as specified in the bid document. This is covered under the BOQ item: "Subscription-based Monitoring Software Model for the supplied helmets (for 6 months on a pilot basis)."

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4.	Shortlisting Criteria 2.1	We request a concession in this clause (The bidder/OEM must have successfully executed Supply of Smart Safety Helmets Enabled with Monitoring Software during last Seven (7) years prior to the originally stipulated last date of Bid submission) for DPIIT-registered startups. As the solution is proprietary and patented, such a concession would encourage greater participation from startups offering innovative solutions in this domain.	There shall be no change in Shortlisting Criteria mentioned in GeM Bid.
5.	Shortlisting Criteria 2.1	We request confirmation on whether similar work executed for international clients will be considered acceptable.	Supply of Smart Safety Helmets Enabled with Monitoring Software successfully executed outside India during last Seven (7) years prior to the originally stipulated last date of Bid submission may also be considered. However, English Transcription of all related documents (Copy of PO/LOA, Completion/Performance Certificate etc) by a Transcription Agency shall be submitted by the bidder.
6.	TS	We seek clarity on the "Recording" use case and the associated server/cloud storage requirements.	It is mentioned in TS under head - 'Video Communication' that 'One-Way video communication with live streaming & recording' is required. (recording with at least 30 days back up).
7.	TS	Need confirmation on applicability of IEC TC 124 Series standard	Yes, IEC TC 124 Series standard compliance is required as per TS.

1. Definition of Class I and Class II suppliers in the bid not in line with the extant Order / Office Memorandum issued by DPIIT in this regard.
2. Seeking EMD submission from bidder(s), including via Additional Terms & Conditions, in contravention to exemption provided to such sellers under GeM GTC.
3. Publishing Custom / BOQ bids for items for which regular GeM categories are available without any Category item bunched with it.
4. Creating BoQ bid for single item.
5. Mentioning specific Brand or Make or Model or Manufacturer or Dealer name.
6. Mandating submission of documents in physical form as a pre-requisite to qualify bidders.
7. Floating / creation of work contracts as Custom Bids in Services.
8. Seeking sample with bid or approval of samples during bid evaluation process. (However, in bids for [attached categories](#), trials are allowed as per approved procurement policy of the buyer nodal Ministries)
9. Mandating foreign / international certifications even in case of existence of Indian Standards without specifying equivalent Indian Certification / standards.
10. Seeking experience from specific organization / department / institute only or from foreign / export experience.
11. Creating bid for items from irrelevant categories.
12. Incorporating any clause against the MSME policy and Preference to Make in India Policy.
13. Reference of conditions published on any external site or reference to external documents/clauses.
14. Asking for any Tender fee / Bid Participation fee / Auction fee in case of Bids / Forward Auction, as the case may be.
15. Buyer added ATC Clauses which are in contravention of clauses defined by buyer in system generated bid template as indicated above in the Bid Details section, EMD Detail, ePBG Detail and MII and MSE Purchase Preference sections of the bid, unless otherwise allowed by GeM GTC.
16. In a category based bid, adding additional items, through buyer added additional scope of work/ additional terms and conditions/or any other document. If buyer needs more items along with the main item, the same must be added through bunching category based items or by bunching custom catalogs or bunching a BoQ with the main category based item, the same must not be done through ATC or Scope of Work.

Further, if any seller has any objection/grievance against these additional clauses or otherwise on any aspect of this bid, they can raise their representation against the same by using the Representation window provided in the bid details field in Seller dashboard after logging in as a seller within 4 days of bid publication on GeM. Buyer is duty bound to reply to all such representations and would not be allowed to open bids if he fails to reply to such representations.
