1.1 QUALIFICATION CRITERIA

Qualification of bidders will be based on meeting the minimum pass/ fail criteria specified bel ow regarding the Bidder's technical experience and financial position as demonstrated by the Bidder's responses in the corresponding Bid Schedules. Technical Experience and Financial Position of any proposed subcontractor shall not be taken into account in determining the Bidder's compliance with the qualifying criteria.

The Owner may assess the capacity and capability of the bidder, to successfully execute the s cope of work covered under the package within stipulated completion period. This assessme nt shall inter-alia include (i) document verification; (ii) bidders work/ facilities visit; (iii) detail s of works executed, works in hand, anticipated in future & the balance capacity available f or the present scope of work; (iv) details of, manpower and financial resources; (v) details of quality systems in place; (vi) past experience and performance; (vii) customer feedback; (viii) banker's feedback etc.

The Employer reserves the right to waive off minor deviations if they do not materially aff ect the capability of a bidder to perform the contract.

1.2 TECHNICAL EXPERIENCE

The Bidder must have **successfully completed#** maintenance services of at least**Ten (1 0) nos.** of Telecom Repeater Shelters/POP **for one (1) year** or more in India in not more th an **three** contracts within last**seven (7)** years as on originally scheduled date of bid openin g i.e... 19.05.2025.

1.3 FINANCIAL POSITION

(a) Minimum Average Annual Turnover *(MAAT) for the best three (3) years i.e. 36 months out of last five (5) financial years of the bidder should be at leastRs. 3,13,43,934/-

4. Price Bid:

- (a) Bidders are requested to quote the price in GeM portal itself. The bid price shall include all the costs for the entire scope of work incl. GST as per the Bidding Documents. The Bic Prices quoted by the bidders cover all the Contractor's obligations mentioned in or to be reasonably inferred from the Bidding Documents to successfully execute the intended services, on "Single Responsibility" basis. Bidders are required to quote the price for the commercial, cont actual and technical obligations outlined in the Bidding Documents including Scope of Work.
- (b) A Price Breakup sheet (in excel) has been attached to the Price Schedule in the bid. Estimate

d cost including Overhead charges (@6.5% of minimum wages) (except Contractor's profit an applicable GST) has been indicated in the price schedules. The Overhead Charges caters to th expenses to be incurred by the Contractor towards procuring labour license, compliance of PF & ESI, operational cost of contract including bank charges towards CPG, cost of manpower repacement as and when required, interest on the amount deducted from the running bills towars TDS, Security Deposit etc. and Cost of coordination / management of the labour engaged in he Contract etc. The above rate of Overhead Charges shall be fixed for entire duration of Conract. 6.5% of overhead charges shall be paid on prevailing minimum wages.

- (c) Bidders are required to fill the profit (excluding GST) as % (percentage) of the base price in he attached Price Breakup and quote the final amount (Incl. GST) in GeM portal, which shall be fixed for entire duration of Contract. Contractor profit margin shall be paid on prevailing mir mum wages. - (d) The above quoted prices are exclusive of Cost of movement/Night Halt charges which shall e provided by POWERTEL to the Contractor as per Technical Specification/Scope of Work.
- (e) In addition to the above, the premium charges of Mediclaim Insurance policy will be eimbursable (Maximum 3.25% of wages) on submission of original receipt for those employees who do not fall under ESI Policy. No additional payment would be paid a gainst this policy.

- 9. Only Class-I Local suppliers are eligible to bid. 'Class-I local supplier' means a supplier or service provider, whose goods, services or works offered for procurement, has Local C ontent equal to 100%. Firms who are not Class-I local supplier shall not be eligible to bid.
- **10.** Earnest Money Deposit (EMD): The Bidder shall furnish, except as exempted herein belo w#, as part of its bid, a bid security in the amount and currency as stipulated below*.

*The amount of Bid Security shall be Rs. 9,86,000/-.

Categories of Bidders exempted from submission of Bid Security are as per GeM GTC. The Bidders exempted from submission of Bid Security shall have to upload the documentary e idence in support of exemption of Bid Security.

- 8. Seeking sample with bid or approval of samples during bid evaluation process. (However, in bids for attacher categories, trials are allowed as per approved procurement policy of the buyer nodal Ministries)
- 9. Mandating foreign / international certifications even in case of existence of Indian Standards without specifying equivalent Indian Certification / standards.
- 10. Seeking experience from specific organization / department / institute only or from foreign / export experience.
- 11. Creating bid for items from irrelevant categories.
- 12. Incorporating any clause against the MSME policy and Preference to Make in India Policy.
- 13. Reference of conditions published on any external site or reference to external documents/clauses.
- 14. Asking for any Tender fee / Bid Participation fee / Auction fee in case of Bids / Forward Auction, as the case may be.
- 15. Any ATC clause in contravention with GeM GTC Clause 4 (xiii)(h) will be invalid. In case of multiple L1 bidders against a service bid, the buyer shall place the Contract by selection of a bidder amongst the L-1 bidders through a Random Algorithm executed by GeM system.
- 16. Buyer added ATC Clauses which are in contravention of clauses defined by buyer in system generated bid template as indicated above in the Bid Details section, EMD Detail, ePBG Detail and MII and MSE Purchase Preference sections of the bid, unless otherwise allowed by GeM GTC.
- 17. In a category based bid, adding additional items, through buyer added additional scope of work/ additional terms and conditions/or any other document. If buyer needs more items along with the main item, the same must be added through bunching category based items or by bunching custom catalogs or bunching a BoQ with the main category based item, the same must not be done through ATC or Scope of Work.

Further, if any seller has any objection/grievance against these additional clauses or otherwise on any aspect of this bid, they can raise their representation against the same by using the Representation window provided in the bid details field in Seller dashboard after logging in as a seller within 4 days of bid publication on GeM. Buyer is duty

bound to reply to all such representations and would not be allowed to open bids if he fails to reply to such representations.
