IFB clause 7.0	<p><u>Modifying IFB clause7.0 regarding Tender Fee</u></p> <p>Due to prevailing situations on account of COVID-19, the nonrefundable fee of Rs. 25000 shall be paid till 17.30 hrs.(IST) on 03.06.2020 via Online Payment only to enable downloading of official copy of bidding documents.</p> <p>Bidders shall submit their Tender Fee through POWERGRID Online Payment Utility Payment mode in the website https://www.powergridindia.com/ or https://epay.powergrid.in/ as a supplier and simultaneously mail us</p> <p>Link for enabling the interested bidder for bid creation will be enabled by POWERGRID only after receipt of "Online payment Reference Number" to cnmwr2@powergrid.co.in or production of documentary evidence towards exemption before closure of sale period as below.</p> <p><i>Micro and Small Enterprises (MSEs) registered with District Industries Centres (DICs) or Khadi & Village Industries Commission (KVIC) or Khadi & Industries Board (KVIB) or Coir Board or National Small Industries Corporation (NSIC) or Directorate of Handicrafts and Handlooms or Udyog Aadhar Memorandum or any</i></p>

		<i>other body specified by Ministry of Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises are exempted from submission of Bid Document Fee as per the Provisions of the Public Procurement Policy for Micro and Small Enterprises (MSEs) order 2012. This shall be subject to production of documentary evidence with regard to registration with authorities mentioned above</i>
2.	BDS clause 2	<p><u>Supplementing BDS clause 2 regarding Bid Security</u></p> <p>Due to prevailing situations on account of COVID-19, the bid shall be submitted by the Bidder in the following manner:</p> <p>Bidder may submit the Bid Security in original at any time before the deadline of the bid submission. In case of non-submission of Bid Security by this time, the bidder shall however, be required to furnish the Bid Security at any time between the date of opening of bids and within a specified timeline of 5(Five) days once the Employer communicates the same. Bidder may note that the Price bid shall not be opened in case of breach of obligation of submission of Bid Security as above besides taking punitive measures as deemed fit. Bidders shall also be required to submit a declaration securing their bid as per Attachment 21 of the Bidding Documents along with the bid or subsequently pursuant to ITB Clause 12. Bidder may also note that the declaration inter-alia contains provision to the extent that non-submission of bid security shall be considered as withdrawal of the bid and would be treated accordingly.</p>
3.	BDS Clause 1,4	<p><u>Supplementing BDS clause regarding submission of Hard Copy of documents</u></p> <p>Bidders submitting bid security other than Online Payment or if exempted because of MSE , has to submit declaration as per Serial No .1 above.</p> <p>Other documents required to be submitted as part of Hard Copy Part of the Bid viz. Power of Attorney ,Affidavit of Self certification regarding Minimum Local Content under PPP-MII order as per bid document shall be scanned and uploaded as part of First Envelope in Soft Copy Part of the Bid</p> <p>Bidder may note that submission of documents required to be executed on non-judicial stamp paper or requirement of attestation/notarization shall also not be a pre-requisite for submission in the scanned form and may be executed on the letterhead of the firm.</p> <p>All these documents shall however be furnished by the successful bidder(s) in original/hard part as per requirement Further, no change shall be permitted in the content of hard copy and earlier submitted scanned copy. Bidder shall also submit an undertaking to this effect along with the soft part of the bid as per Attachment- 22 of the Bidding Documents along with the bid. Bidder may also note that the undertaking inter-alia contains provision to the extent that non-submission of these documents as above shall be considered as withdrawal of the bid and would be treated accordingly.</p>

		<p>The provisions specified at other clauses of the Bidding Documents shall be read in conjunction with the provisions specified hereinabove.</p> <p>Notwithstanding the above, Employer reserves the right to modify/revise or restore the provisions keeping in view the changes in the circumstances.</p>
3.	BDS clause 3	<p>Add new Clauses ITB 9.3(v) and ITB 9.3(w):</p> <p>(q) Attachment 21: Declaration for securing the bid in case of non-submission of Bid Security before the deadline of bid submission</p> <p>(r) Attachment 22: Undertaking regarding submission of original/Hard copy part of the bid except for Bid Security</p>
4.	Add new BDS Clause	<p><u>Supplementing ITB clause ITB 9.2,13.1.1</u></p> <p>In case of non-submission of bid in the portal (soft copy part of the bid) within the stipulated deadline, then even if the bidder has submitted the specific documents in hard copy in original within the stipulated deadline pursuant to ITB 8.1.1, its bid shall be considered as incomplete bid, which shall be summarily rejected.</p> <p>Similarly, in case of non-submission of hard copy part of the bid, but the bidder has uploaded the soft copy part of the bid, the bid will be considered as incomplete bid. In such a case, the soft copy part of the first envelope bid uploaded on the portal shall be opened. Such bids will be rejected during preliminary examination.</p> <p>However, in case of MSEs who are exempted from submission of bid security in line with ITB 3.0, non-submission of hard copy part shall not lead to outright rejection of the bid, but the documents required to be submitted in the hard copy part shall be sought through clarifications as brought out at ITB 12.0.</p>
