

Bid Corrigendum

Following terms and conditions supersede all existing "Buyer added Bid Specific Terms and conditions" given in the bid document or any previous corrigendum. Prospective bidders are advised to bid as per following Terms and Conditions:

Buyer Added Bid Specific Additional Terms and Conditions

1. Buyer Added text based ATC clauses
 - (i) Terms and conditions of the Bidding Documents uploaded under BuyerATC on GeM portal and provisions mentioned hereinbelow, will supersede the GeM GTC and the provisions mentioned above.
 - (ii) Bid is reserved for Class-I Local Suppliers. Local Content of 60% for Class-I Local Supplier indicated in bid against each of the BOQ item is for the entire package and not for the respective individual item.
 - (iii) Delivery Period indicated above against each of the BOQ item is total Contract duration for the subject package. Delivery period requirement shall be in line with BuyerATC.
 - (iv) Primary product appearing above is for indicative purpose only. The relevant provisions regarding the same shall be governed as per BuyerATC
 - (v) Document required from seller shall be governed as per the provisions of the documents enclosed in BuyerATC.
 - (vi) Eligibility Criterion shall be governed as per the provisions of stipulated Qualifying Requirement (QR) enclosed in BuyerATC.
 - (vii) Exemption to Start-Ups / MSEs and requirement of e-PBG/CPG shall be governed as per the provisions of the documents enclosed in BuyerATC.
 - (viii) Warranty/Defect Liability Period of Equipments to be procured under subject package shall be in line with Clause GCC 22.1 in SCC enclosed in BuyerATC.
 - (ix) Bid Security shall not be applicable in this Package. All the Bidders shall submit as part of their bid, a Bid Securing Declaration in the format given in the BuyerATC.
2. Bidder shall submit the following documents along with their bid for Vendor Code Creation:
 - a. Copy of PAN Card.
 - b. Copy of GSTIN.
 - c. Copy of Cancelled Cheque.
 - d. Copy of EFT Mandate duly certified by Bank.
3. Buyer Organization specific Integrity Pact shall have to be complied by all bidders. Bidders shall have to

Disclaimer

The additional terms and conditions have been incorporated by the Buyer after approval of the Competent Authority in Buyer Organization, whereby Buyer organization is solely responsible for the impact of these clauses on the bidding process, its outcome, and consequences thereof including any eccentricity / restriction arising in the bidding process due to these ATCs and due to modification of technical specifications and / or terms and conditions governing the bid. If any clause(s) is / are incorporated by the Buyer regarding following, the bid and resultant contracts shall be treated as null and void and such bids may be cancelled by GeM at any stage of bidding process without any notice:-

1. Definition of Class I and Class II suppliers in the bid not in line with the extant Order / Office Memorandum issued by DPIIT in this regard.
2. Seeking EMD submission from bidder(s), including via Additional Terms & Conditions, in contravention to exemption provided to such sellers under GeM GTC.
3. Publishing Custom / BOQ bids for items for which regular GeM categories are available without any Category item bunched with it.
4. Creating BoQ bid for single item.
5. Mentioning specific Brand or Make or Model or Manufacturer or Dealer name.
6. Mandating submission of documents in physical form as a pre-requisite to qualify bidders.
7. Floating / creation of work contracts as Custom Bids in Services.
8. Seeking sample with bid or approval of samples during bid evaluation process. (However, in bids for [attached categories](#), trials are allowed as per approved procurement policy of the buyer nodal Ministries)
9. Mandating foreign / international certifications even in case of existence of Indian Standards without specifying equivalent Indian Certification / standards.
10. Seeking experience from specific organization / department / institute only or from foreign / export experience.
11. Creating bid for items from irrelevant categories.
12. Incorporating any clause against the MSME policy and Preference to Make in India Policy.
13. Reference of conditions published on any external site or reference to external documents/clauses.
14. Asking for any Tender fee / Bid Participation fee / Auction fee in case of Bids / Forward Auction, as the case may be.
15. Buyer added ATC Clauses which are in contravention of clauses defined by buyer in system generated bid template as indicated above in the Bid Details section, EMD Detail, ePBG Detail and MII and MSE Purchase Preference sections of the bid, unless otherwise allowed by GeM GTC.
16. In a category based bid, adding additional items, through buyer added additional scope of work/ additional terms and conditions/or any other document. If buyer needs more items along with the main item, the same must be added through bunching category based items or by bunching custom catalogs or bunching a BoQ with the main category based item, the same must not be done through ATC or Scope of Work.

Further, if any seller has any objection/grievance against these additional clauses or otherwise on any aspect of this bid, they can raise their representation against the same by using the Representation window provided in the bid details field in Seller dashboard after logging in as a seller within 4 days of bid publication on GeM. Buyer is duty bound to reply to all such representations and would not be allowed to open bids if he fails to reply to such representations.
