Buyer Added Bid Specific Additional Terms and Conditions

1. Bidder shall submit the following documents along with their bid for Vendor Code Creation:
 - a. Copy of PAN Card.
 - b. Copy of GSTIN.
 - c. Copy of Cancelled Cheque.
 - d. Copy of EFT Mandate duly certified by Bank.
2. Buyer Organization specific Integrity Pact shall have to be complied by all bidders. Bidders shall have to upload scanned copy of signed integrity pact as per Buyer organizations policy along with bid. [Click here to view the file](#)
3. **Manufacturer Authorization:** Wherever Authorised Distributors/service providers are submitting the bid, Authorisation Form /Certificate with OEM/Original Service Provider details such as name, designation, address, e-mail Id and Phone No. required to be furnished along with the bid
4. Without prejudice to Buyer's right to price adjustment by way of discount or any other right or remedy available to Buyer, Buyer may terminate the Contract or any part thereof by a written notice to the Seller, if:
 - i) The Seller fails to comply with any material term of the Contract.
 - ii) The Seller informs Buyer of its inability to deliver the Material(s) or any part thereof within the stipulated Delivery Period or such inability otherwise becomes apparent.
 - iii) The Seller fails to deliver the Material(s) or any part thereof within the stipulated Delivery Period and/or to replace/rectify any rejected or defective Material(s) promptly.
 - iv) The Seller becomes bankrupt or goes into liquidation.
 - v) The Seller makes a general assignment for the benefit of creditors.
 - vi) A receiver is appointed for any substantial property owned by the Seller.
 - vii) The Seller has misrepresented to Buyer, acting on which misrepresentation Buyer has placed the Purchase Order on the Seller.
5. Scope of supply (Bid price to include all cost components) : Supply Installation Testing and Commissioning of Goods
6. Bidder's offer is liable to be rejected if they don't upload any of the certificates / documents sought in the Bid document, ATC and Corrigendum if any.
7. Bidders can also submit the EMD with Account Payee Demand Draft in favour of Power Grid Corporation of India Limited payable at Lucknow.
Bidder has to upload scanned copy / proof of the DD along with bid and has to ensure delivery of hardcopy to the Buyer within 5 days of Bid End date / Bid Opening date.
8. Bidders can also submit the EMD with Banker's Cheque in favour of Power Grid Corporation of India Limited payable at

In case of discrepancy in price(s) quoted in GeM portal and BOQ Breakup provided by the bidder, the price(s) in GeM shall prevail and POWERGRID reserves the right to ask bidder for clarification in this regard.

2.		Please specify the minimum percentage of local content required for the "IP based PT Z Camera" to comply with the Public Procurement (Preference to Make in India) order.	Minimum Local Contents should be as per follows; Class-I MLC 50%, Class-II MLC 20%
3.		Clause 382 mentions testing for embedded malware/trojans for any imported components. Please clarify if the STQC certification for the camera covers this requirement or if additional third-party lab testing is mandatory.	Third-party lab testing shall be required for embedded malware/trojans for any imported components in case STQC certification for the camera does not cover this requirement.
4.	BoQ	The BOQ lists multiple consignees (Alipurduar, Rajarhat, Birpara, Siliguri, Gangtok, Durgapur, Berhampore, Subhashgram, Binaguri). Please confirm if the bidder must conduct site surveys at all these locations before supply to finalize cable lengths.	Cable Supply is not in the scope of the successful bidder under this package. However, cable laying involved shall be in the scope of the successful bidder.

Please clarify the required U-size (e.g., 6U, 9U, 42U) and whether these racks are to be installed indoors (Control Room) or outdoors (Switchyard).	Rack mounting panel is required only for Alipurduar SS. The size shall be 17 U or higher. The racks are to be installed indoors.
7.		Please clarify the "Inspection Level" (Level I, II, or III) applicable for the PTZ Cameras and Media Converters to understand if Factory Acceptance Test (FAT) witnessing is required.	Inspection of items is to be done at site after receipt of material at respective sites
8.	General	Please confirm if the cameras must be integrated into an existing Video Management System (VMS) at the sites. If yes, please provide the make and version of the existing VMS for compatibility verification for all locations.	Bidders have to demonstrate successful integration of the offered camera model with existing VMS system of POWERGRID during pre-award stage if the offered model is not integrated with existing VMS system previously. It may please be noted that it is the responsibility of Bidder to Demonstrate Successful integration of camera model with VMS system {Nice Vision (Qognify)} of POWERGRID and accordingly arranging required support from Nice Vision (Qognify) is the responsibility of bidder only

9.		The specification mentions "STQC approved model". Please clarify if the bidder must submit the STQC certificate at the time of bid submission or if it can be provided before the supply of material.	The offered camera should comply with the Essential Requirements (ERs) for security prescribed by MeitY to ensure the security of the VMS system of POWERGRID. The security testing report for Camera issued by Standardization Testing and Quality Certification (STQC) Laboratory or any other agency notified by MeitY is mandatory before dispatch of item to respective locations by the supplier. The STQC/ER certificates and EMC compliance are required to be submitted by the successful bidder before issue of dispatch clearance.
10.		The Bill of Quantity (BOQ) specifies exact lengths for FO cables (8000m), Power cables (15000m), and HDPE pipes (8000m). Please clarify if these quantities are firm or if payment will be based on actual joint measurements at the site.	Payment for laying of FO cables, Power Cables and HDPE pipes will be done as per actual joint measurement at site and subject to amendment also. Only laying of these items as per actual is in scope of successful bidder and not the supply part of it.
11.		The installation scope includes "LIU with splicing etc.". Please confirm if the bidder is responsible for providing all splicing kits, pigtailed, and specialized tools required for fiber termination at all sites.	Yes, bidder is responsible for providing all necessary tools and materials for fiber termination and splicing.
12.		The document states POWERGRID has standardized drawings that can be used. Please clarify if site-specific layout drawings are required from the bidder or if standard drawings will be sufficient for the camera mounting arrangements.	Site-specific layout drawings shall be required at the time of Detailed Engineering if standard drawings are sufficient for the camera mounting arrangements

All representations / grievances pertaining to the ATC clauses shall be raised with the buyer organization directly and not with GeM. If any of the clause(s) is/are incorporated by the Buyer regarding the following, the bid & resultant contract shall be treated as null & void. Further, GeM reserves the right, at its sole discretion, to cancel the bid forthwith, without issuance of any prior notice or intimation :-

1. Publishing Custom / BOQ bids for items for which regular GeM categories are available (unless such Custom / BOQ item is bunched with the major regular product Category Item).
2. Mandating procurement of / from specific Brand / Make / Model / Manufacturer / Dealer except in case of Single Bid / Proprietary Article Certificate (PAC) Buying.
3. Inclusion of disqualification criteria related to suspension of seller / service provider, where such suspension period has already expired.
4. Mandating submission of documents in physical form as a pre-requisite to qualify bidders.
5. Publishing bids on GeM for procurement of works.
6. Procurement of Goods by creating a Service bid on GeM & vice-versa.
7. Seeking sample with bid or approval of samples during bid evaluation process. However, trial / sample, as the case may be, shall be permitted in cases where trial / sample are allowed as per approved and published procurement policy of the Buyers' controlling Ministry / Department / State / Public Sector Enterprises Headquarters. If there is any violation of trial / sample clause with regard to approved policy of the Buyers' Ministry / Department / State / Public Sector Enterprises Headquarters, then this is to be determined and redressed by the concerned Buyer Organisation only.
8. Seeking experience from specific organization / department / institute only or from foreign / export experience.
9. Creating bid for items from incorrect categories.
10. Reference of conditions published on any external site or reference to external documents/clauses.
11. Asking for any Tender fee / Bid Participation fee, as the case may be.
12. Buyer added ATC Clauses which are in contravention of clauses defined in bid detail section, including specifications, EMD Detail, ePBG Detail and MII and MSE Purchase Preference sections of the bid, unless otherwise allowed by the applicable GeM GTC.
13. Any ATC clause in contravention with GeM GTC Clause 4 (xiii) (h) will be invalid. In case of multiple L1 bidders against a service bid, the buyer shall place the Contract by selection of a bidder amongst the L-1 bidders through a Random Algorithm executed by GeM system.
14. In a category based bid, adding additional items, through buyer added, additional scope of work/ additional terms and conditions/or any other document. If buyer needs more items along with the main item, the same must be added through bunching category based items or by bunching custom catalogues or bunching a BoQ with the main category based item, the same must not be done through ATC or Scope of Work.

Further, if any seller has any objection/grievance against these additional clauses or otherwise on any aspect of this bid, they can raise their representation against the same by using the Representation window provided in the bid details field in Seller dashboard after logging in as a seller. Buyer is duty bound to reply to all such representations and would not be allowed to open bids if he fails to reply to such representations.
