Following terms and conditions supersede all existing "Buyer added Bid Specific Terms and conditions" given in the bid document or any previous corrigendum. Prospective bidders are advised to bid as per following Terms and Conditions:

Buyer Added Bid Specific Additional Terms and Conditions

1. Bidders are advised to check applicable GST on their own before quoting. Buyer will not take any responsibility in this regards. GST reimbursement will be as per actuals or as per applicable rates (whichever is lower), subject to the maximum of quoted GST %.
2. Bidder shall submit the following documents along with their bid for Vendor Code Creation:
 - a. Copy of PAN Card.
 - b. Copy of GSTIN.
 - c. Copy of Cancelled Cheque.
 - d. Copy of EFT Mandate duly certified by Bank.
3. Bidder's offer is liable to be rejected if they don't upload any of the certificates / documents sought in the Bid document, ATC and Corrigendum if any.
4. Buyer Added text based ATC clauses
 1. **Payment terms: 100% on successful delivery, material verification and submission of CPG.**
 2. **Delivery Period: 08 weeks.**
 3. **Warranty: 1 year after supply and joint verification of material at PowerTel premises.**
 4. **The Bidding will also be governed by all the bidding documents uploaded at "Buyer Added Bid Specific ATC/Additional Scope of Work". Bidders are requested to kindly go through it before submission of their bid.**
 5. **QR: The Qualifying Requirements like Technical Experience and Financial Position (MAAT) of bidders shall be as per QR uploaded in "Buyer Added Bid Specific ATC/Additional Scope of Work". Bidders shall upload the documents as proof of compliance with the Qualifying Requirement.**
 6. **Bidders shall not upload the Price schedule in technical part of the Bid in soft copy and shall not submit any Price component in Hard copy of the bid, otherwise their bid shall be rejected and no further clarification shall be sought.**
 7. **The mandatory documents to be uploaded/submitted in soft/hard copies by bidders: -**
 - a. **Proof of the Bid Security (EMD) by the bidders. The bidders who are exempted from submission of EMD shall submit documentary evidence for the same.**
 - b. **Duly filled and signed Attachments as attached in "Buyer Added Bid Specific ATC".**

Bidders shall submit self-certification regarding Local Content in line with PPP-MII order and DoT Order, on a non-judicial stamp paper of Rs. 100/-. (Format given in Attachment-2). Attachment-1, 3 & 4 shall be submitted as self-declaration on company's letterhead.

3. Publishing Custom / BOQ bids for items for which regular GeM categories are available without any Category item bunched with it.
4. Creating BoQ bid for single item.
5. Mentioning specific Brand or Make or Model or Manufacturer or Dealer name.
6. Mandating submission of documents in physical form as a pre-requisite to qualify bidders.
7. Floating / creation of work contracts as Custom Bids in Services.
8. Seeking sample with bid or approval of samples during bid evaluation process. (However, in bids for [attached categories](#), trials are allowed as per approved procurement policy of the buyer nodal Ministries)
9. Mandating foreign / international certifications even in case of existence of Indian Standards without specifying equivalent Indian Certification / standards.
10. Seeking experience from specific organization / department / institute only or from foreign / export experience.
11. Creating bid for items from irrelevant categories.

12. Incorporating any clause against the MSME policy and Preference to Make in India Policy.
13. Reference of conditions published on any external site or reference to external documents/clauses.
14. Asking for any Tender fee / Bid Participation fee / Auction fee in case of Bids / Forward Auction, as the case may be.
