Following terms and conditions supersede all existing "Buyer added Bid Specific Terms and conditions" given in the bid document or any previous corrigendum. Prospective bidders are advised to bid as per following Terms and Conditions:

Buyer Added Bid Specific Additional Terms and Conditions

- 1. Buyer uploaded ATC document Click here to view the file.
- 2. Bidder shall submit the following documents along with their bid for Vendor Code Creation:
 - a. Copy of PAN Card.
 - b. Copy of GSTIN.
 - c. Copy of Cancelled Cheque.
 - d. Copy of EFT Mandate duly certified by Bank.
- 3. Buyer Organization specific Integrity Pact shall have to be complied by all bidders. Bidders shall have to upload scanned copy of signed integrity pact as per Buyer organizations policy along with bid. Click here to view the file
- 4. Buyer Added text based ATC clauses
 - (i) Terms and conditions of Vol-I, II and III of the Bidding Documents uploaded under BuyerATC on GeM por tal and provisions mentioned hereinbelow, will supersede the GeM GTC and the provisions mentioned above.
 - (ii) Consignee indicated in the GeM Bidding is indicative only for the purpose of GeM bidding. The Actual consignee details shall be shared during execution of the contract at the time of Delivery Instruction.
 - (iii) Document required from seller shall be governed as per the provisions of the documents enclosed in BuyerATC.
 - (iv) Bidders are requested to quote the price in GeM portal itself. The prices (including taxes and duties) Quoted by Bidders on GeM portal shall be final and shall be considered for evaluation and award purposes.
 - (v) Buyer Organization Specific Integrity Pact shall have to be complied by all bidders. Bidders shall have to upload scanned copy of signed Integrity Pact as per buyer organizations policy along with Bid.
 - (vi) The Purchaser will split the quantity of Goods & related Services (rounded to the nearest figure) and award the contract(s) for the same into Two bidders, L1 (Lowest evaluated Bidder) and L2 (Second Lowest evaluated Bidder), whose bids have been determined to be substantially responsive, in equal quantity with the condition that L2 shall match the price of L1 Bidder offered for subject package subject to meeting the requirement of MSE/PPP-MII Policy in vogue and while matching the prices, L2 shall not be allowed to increase any component (Ex-Works/F&I) of their quoted prices.

Further, in case L2 does not match the price of L1, then the next lowest evaluated bidder shall be considered for a ward and so on so forth with the condition of matching the L1 bidder price. In case no bidder agrees to match the p rice of L1, left over quantity shall not be awarded and only one development order shall be awarded to the L1 bidde r for only 1 set of ERS subject to meeting the requirement of MSE/PPP-MII Policy in vogue.

Disclaimer

The additional terms and conditions have been incorporated by the Buyer after approval of the Competent Authority in Buyer Organization, whereby Buyer organization is solely responsible for the impact of these clauses on the bidding process, its outcome, and consequences thereof including any eccentricity / restriction arising in the bidding process due to these ATCs and due to modification of technical specifications and / or terms and conditions governing the bid. If any clause(s) is / are incorporated by the Buyer regarding following, the bid and resultant contracts shall be treated as null and void and such bids may be cancelled by GeM at any stage of bidding process without any notice:-

- 1. Definition of Class I and Class II suppliers in the bid not in line with the extant Order / Office Memorandum issued by DPIIT in this regard.
- 2. Seeking EMD submission from bidder(s), including via Additional Terms & Conditions, in contravention to exemption provided to such sellers under GeM GTC.
- 3. Publishing Custom / BOQ bids for items for which regular GeM categories are available without any Category item bunched with it.
- 4. Creating BoQ bid for single item.
- 5. Mentioning specific Brand or Make or Model or Manufacturer or Dealer name.
- 6. Mandating submission of documents in physical form as a pre-requisite to qualify bidders.
- 7. Floating / creation of work contracts as Custom Bids in Services.
- 8. Seeking sample with bid or approval of samples during bid evaluation process. (However, in bids for attached categories, trials are allowed as per approved procurement policy of the buyer nodal Ministries)
- 9. Mandating foreign / international certifications even in case of existence of Indian Standards without specifying equivalent Indian Certification / standards.
- 10. Seeking experience from specific organization / department / institute only or from foreign / export experience.
- 11. Creating bid for items from irrelevant categories.
- 12. Incorporating any clause against the MSME policy and Preference to Make in India Policy.
- 13. Reference of conditions published on any external site or reference to external documents/clauses.
- 14. Asking for any Tender fee / Bid Participation fee / Auction fee in case of Bids / Forward Auction, as the case may be.
- 15. Buyer added ATC Clauses which are in contravention of clauses defined by buyer in system generated bid template as indicated above in the Bid Details section, EMD Detail, ePBG Detail and MII and MSE Purchase Preference sections of the bid, unless otherwise allowed by GeM GTC.
- 16. In a category based bid, adding additional items, through buyer added additional scope of work/ additional terms and conditions/or any other document. If buyer needs more items along with the main item, the same must be added through bunching category based items or by bunching custom catalogs or bunching a BoQ with the main category based item, the same must not be done through ATC or Scope of Work.

Further, if any seller has any objection/grievance against these additional clauses or otherwise on any aspect of this bid, they can raise their representation against the same by using the Representation window provided in the bid details field in Seller dashboard after logging in as a seller within 4 days of bid publication on GeM. Buyer is duty bound to reply to all such representations and would not be allowed to open bids if he fails to reply to such representations.
