1. Bidders can also submit the EMD with Payment online through RTGS / internet banking in Beneficiary name

Bidder to indicate bid number and name of bidding entity in the transaction details field at the time of on-line transfer. Bidder has to upload scanned copy / proof of the Online Payment Transfer along with bid.

2. Buyer Added text based ATC clauses

1. **Quantity variation of (+/-) 25% of the Original award value where the quantity of individual items may vary up to any extent as per site requirements.** This shall supersede any QV provision in TS.

2. "Any other Documents As per Specific Requirement of Buyer -1" need to be filled and uploaded on GeM portal only. Soft copy of the same is attached at Buyer Added Bid Specific ATC document to facilitate bidders.

In case of non-submission of bid in the portal (soft copy part of the bid) within the stipulated deadline, the bidder even if the bidder has submitted the specific documents in hard copy part in original within the stipulated deadline pursuant to ITB 17.1, its bid shall be considered as incomplete bid, which shall be summarily rejected.

3. Qualification requirements shall be as per POWERGRID T&C as attached at Project Experience and Qualifying Criteria Requirement. Documents supporting the QR compliance both Financial and Technical to be uploaded by the bidder on portal.

4. Power of Attorney, Integrity Pact, Safety Pact, Bid Security, Attachment-20, Attachment-21, Attachment-22 & Attachment-23 need to be uploaded on portal and Original hard copy of same to be submitted to the address: DGM [CS], Power Grid Corporation of India Ltd., Eastern Region Telecom Control Center, 1st Floor, CF-17, Action Area-1C, New Town, Rajarhat, Kolkata-700156.

5. Bidders uploading the duly filled BOQ in the technical bid shall be rejected and no further clarification shall be sought.

6. While generating invoice in GeM portal, the seller must upload scanned copy of GST invoice and the screenshot of GST portal confirming payment of GST.

7. Supplier shall ensure that the Invoice is raised in the name of Consignee with GSTIN of Consignee only.

8. Additional changes in ITB and Attachment 20 of Any other Documents As per Specific Requirement of Buyer -1 incorporated vide corrigendum dated 16.10.2023 has been indicated in ATC document.

9. MSE Relaxation has been revised in Qualifying Requirements attached at Project Experience and Qualifying Criteria Requirement as follows:

Any clause(s) incorporated by the Buyer regarding following shall be treated as null and void and would not be considered as part of bid:-

1. Definition of Class I and Class II suppliers in the bid not in line with the extant Order / Office Memorandum issued by DPIIT in this regard.
2. Seeking EMD submission from bidder(s), including via Additional Terms & Conditions, in contravention to

exemption provided to such sellers under GeM GTC.

3. Publishing Custom / BOQ bids for items for which regular GeM categories are available without any Category item bunched with it.
4. Creating BoQ bid for single item.
5. Mentioning specific Brand or Make or Model or Manufacturer or Dealer name.
6. Mandating submission of documents in physical form as a pre-requisite to qualify bidders.
7. Floating / creation of work contracts as Custom Bids in Services.
8. Seeking sample with bid or approval of samples during bid evaluation process.
9. Mandating foreign / international certifications even in case of existence of Indian Standards without specifying equivalent Indian Certification / standards.
10. Seeking experience from specific organization / department / institute only or from foreign / export experience.
11. Creating bid for items from irrelevant categories.
12. Incorporating any clause against the MSME policy and Preference to Make in India Policy.
13. Reference of conditions published on any external site or reference to external documents/clauses.
14. Asking for any Tender fee / Bid Participation fee / Auction fee in case of Bids / Forward Auction, as the case may be.

Further, if any seller has any objection/grievance against these additional clauses or otherwise on any aspect of this bid, they can raise their representation against the same by using the Representation window provided in the bid details field in Seller dashboard after logging in as a seller within 4 days of bid publication on GeM. Buyer is duty bound to reply to all such representations and would not be allowed to open bids if he fails to reply to such representations.
