2. Bidder's offer is liable to be rejected if they don't upload any of the certificates / documents sought in the Bid document, ATC and Corrigendum if any.

5. Buyer Added text based ATC clauses

I) Name of the Package: Substation Automation System (SAS) upgradation of 27 no. substations of OPTCL including AMC under STAMS Project Consultancy services to OPTCL [Spec.no: ODP/BB/C&M-3768/GeM-41/24-25]

II) Bidder shall have to fill and mandatorily upload the following forms along with their bid:

- b) Information regarding Ex-Employees of POWERGRID in our organization (**Refer Form No. 2**)
- c) Certificate from the OEM/Service Provider regarding the percentage of the local content and the details of locations at which the local value addition is made, if applicable (**Refer Form No. 3A**)
- d) Certificate from statutory auditor or cost auditor of the company (in the case of companies) or from a practicing cost accountant or practicing chartered accountant (in respect of suppliers other than companies) giving the percentage of Local Content, if applicable, duly signed and stamped on each page, in line with PPP-MII Order and MoP Order (**Refer Form No. 3B**)
- e) Buyer Specific Integrity Pact as per format available on a non-judicial stamp paper of Rs. 100/- (**Refer Form No. 4**)
- f) Undertaking by the bidder regarding Compliance of DMI & SP policy. (**Refer Form No. 5**)
- g) Declaration by the Bidder regarding events encountered pursuant to Bid specific ATC clause 3 (**Refer Form No. 6**)
- h) Certification by the Bidder as per DoE Order in line with Bid specific ATC clause 3 (**Refer Form No. 7**)
- i) Declaration of Key Managerial Person and Power of Attorney holder regarding Balance Bid Capacity (**Refer Form No. 8**)
- j) Undertaking regarding submission of original/hard copy part of bid (**Refer Form No. 9**)

- k) All the required documents as per Qualifying Requirement (Annexure-QR)
- l) Filled Format for Furnishing the details in support of QR and documents mentioned therein (refer "Form at-QR")
- m) Power of Attorney and Joint Venture Agreement (Form no. 10 & 11, if applicable)

Disclaimer

The additional terms and conditions have been incorporated by the Buyer after approval of the Competent Authority in Buyer Organization, whereby Buyer organization is solely responsible for the impact of these clauses on the bidding process, its outcome, and consequences thereof including any eccentricity / restriction arising in the bidding process due to these ATCs and due to modification of technical specifications and / or terms and conditions governing the bid. If any clause(s) is / are incorporated by the Buyer regarding following, the bid and resultant contracts shall be treated as null and void and such bids may be cancelled by GeM at any stage of bidding process without any notice:-

1. Definition of Class I and Class II suppliers in the bid not in line with the extant Order / Office Memorandum issued by DPIIT in this regard.
2. Seeking EMD submission from bidder(s), including via Additional Terms & Conditions, in contravention to exemption provided to such sellers under GeM GTC.
3. Publishing Custom / BOQ bids for items for which regular GeM categories are available without any Category item bunched with it.
4. Creating BoQ bid for single item.
5. Mentioning specific Brand or Make or Model or Manufacturer or Dealer name.
6. Mandating submission of documents in physical form as a pre-requisite to qualify bidders.
7. Floating / creation of work contracts as Custom Bids in Services.
8. Seeking sample with bid or approval of samples during bid evaluation process. (However, in bids for [attached categories](#), trials are allowed as per approved procurement policy of the buyer nodal Ministries)
9. Mandating foreign / international certifications even in case of existence of Indian Standards without specifying equivalent Indian Certification / standards.
10. Seeking experience from specific organization / department / institute only or from foreign / export experience.
11. Creating bid for items from irrelevant categories.
12. Incorporating any clause against the MSME policy and Preference to Make in India Policy.
13. Reference of conditions published on any external site or reference to external documents/clauses.
14. Asking for any Tender fee / Bid Participation fee / Auction fee in case of Bids / Forward Auction, as the case may be.
15. Any ATC clause in contravention with GeM GTC Clause 4 (xiii)(h) will be invalid. In case of multiple L1 bidders against a service bid, the buyer shall place the Contract by selection of a bidder amongst the L-1 bidders through a Random Algorithm executed by GeM system.

Further, if any seller has any objection/grievance against these additional clauses or otherwise on any aspect of this bid, they can raise their representation against the same by using the Representation window provided in the bid details field in Seller dashboard after logging in as a seller within 4 days of bid publication on GeM. Buyer is duty bound to reply to all such representations and would not be allowed to open bids if he fails to reply to such representations.
