1. Total Annual Procurement pertains to the category of Packages which are in the ambit of the Public Procurement Policy for MSEs Order 2012.

(*) During FY 2023-24, a total procurement of Rs 48.62 **Crore** was made from Micro and Small Enterprises owned by Scheduled Caste or Scheduled Tribe Entrepreneurs under the ambit of the PPP for MSEs. Procurements from all the MSEs is 57.52% of total value of such procurements during FY 2023-24 and as such the sub-target was met as per the Public Procurement Policy for MSEs Order 2012, and its Amendment dated: 09.11.2018, which, inter alia, directs that in event of failure of such Micro and Small Enterprises to participate in tender process or meet tender requirements and L1 price, 4 percent sub-target for procurement earmarked for Micro and Small Enterprises owned by Scheduled Caste or Scheduled Tribe entrepreneurs shall be met from other Micro and Small Enterprises. Hence the target is met in line with the Public Procurement Policy for MSEs Order 2012.

In above context, it may also be stated that POWERGRID, through Buyer-Seller Meets and Special Vendor Development Programmes (special VDP), is encouraging MSEs owned by Scheduled Caste or the Scheduled Tribe Entrepreneurs and Women Entrepreneurs to participate in the procurement process of POWERGRID. During this financial year, in order to encourage and develop Micro and Small manufacturers for supply of innovative & quality products, **18 nos.** of VDPs have been organized in various parts of the country. Out of which **09 nos.** of VDPs were specially organized for SC/SC and women owned MSEs.
