### EXPERIENCE: A Brief on SAMBHAV 2014

- a. The ninth edition of SAMBHAV, showcasing the artistic talent of physically and mentally challenged artistes from 16 countries including India, had concluded in the weekend of 14, 15 & 16 November 2014 with a resounding success. The three-day festival, organised annually by A.L.P.A.N.A. Society, in 2014, attracted groups from Australia, Bangladesh, Bhutan, India, Indonesia, Iran, Israel, Mauritius, Myanmar, Nepal, Pakistan, Russia, South Africa, Sri Lanka, Thailand and Vietnam besides groups from Indian States of Delhi, Gujarat, Andhra Pradesh, Madhya Pradesh, Karnataka and Meghalaya. It included International seminars on artistic empowerment of disabled persons, an exhibition of art and craft by the challenged artists from participating countries, signing of MoUs, yoga lessons and performances by twenty three troupes from sixteen countries at India International Centre, New Delhi.
- b. SAMBHAV 2014 was launched in the morning of 14 November 2014 by Dr Harsh Vardhan, Hon'ble Union Minister for Science and Technology. He exhorted the scientists to work for developing new technologies for challenged artists.
- c. The Welcome Ceremony of SAMBHAV 2014 witnessed Shri K.K. Mittal, Additional Secretary to the Government of India in the Ministry of Culture as Chief Guest. Career Diplomat Mr Anwar Haleem, Ambassador of Mongolia to India Mr Sanjay Suren Bayara and Counsellor (Culture) in Russian Embassy Ms Nana M Mgeladze were the Distinguished Guests at the welcome ceremony. Mr Mittal appreciated the work of A.L.P.A.N.A Society in fulfilling an important role of Indian society towards the global community. Carrying their national flags, twenty three groups from sixteen countries attired in their country's national dress took Sambhav pledge to work towards inclusive growth through inclusive arts. The colourful start had welcome song by challenged artists of A.L.P.A.N.A.
- d. Art and craft exhibition was inaugurated by Padma Vibhushan Dr. Kapila Vatsayan. She was also the Chief Guest at the inaugural international performances on 14 November 2014.
- e. SAMBHAV 2014 was a platform, where four Memoranda of Understanding (MOUs) were signed between A.L.P.A.N.A Society and the representatives of organisations from four different countries that have been working for inclusive growth of mentally and physically challenged persons through performing arts. The objective of these MoUs was to share the experience in the field for mutual benefit and to provide such platforms in the countries of the signatories to stage similar participative efforts. The MOUs were signed with organisations from Russia, Mauritius, Myanmar and South Africa. The MoU signing ceremony was chaired by Career Diplomat Ms Sripriya Ranganathan.
- f. The International Seminar was inaugurated by Guruji Dr. H. R. Nagendra, Chancellor, S-VYASA Deemed University, Bangalore. In three sessions of the

**SAMBHAV 2015** will include:

- i. International Seminar on "Challenges of working with Persons with Disability for inclusive growth with special focus on inclusive arts." Papers and experiences shall be presented by experts and practitioners.
  - ii. Forum for International Cooperation to advance the Rights of Women, the Rights of Children and the Rights of Persons with Disability. It aims to encourage people to people contact through formal Memorandum of Understanding.
  - iii. International Exhibition of art and craft made by challenged artists.
  - iv. Forum for Exposure to Yoga and Persons with Disability.
  - v. International Event of Performances by challenged artists from different countries
- d. SAMBHAV 2015 will have the following categories of participation:

**Category A. Performing Artists with Disabilities**

Performing artists with different kinds of disabilities i.e. visual impairment, hearing impairment, locomotor disorder, intellectual disabilities etc. They will be from different countries of the world. They will put up performances (20 to 25 minutes duration by each group) during SAMBHAV 2015.

**Category B. Experts and practitioners working with challenged persons**

Domain experts, gurus, dance therapists, music therapists, mental health professionals, yoga practitioners, medical doctors, art instructors, therapy administrators, policy makers, diplomats, media persons, legal professionals, rights advocates, students etc. will attend the international seminar. They will be from different countries of the world.

**Category C. Challenged Artists**

Challenged painters, sculptors, weavers, designers etc. They will exhibit their arts and artifacts at the international exhibition. They will be from different countries of the world.

**Category D. Managers of organizations working with PsWD**

Executives, managers, mentors and leaders of organizations, including service providers and innovators working for Persons with Disability from different countries will be part of the Forum on International Cooperation.

**Category E. Caretakers and Caregivers for Persons With Disability (PsWD)**

Caretakers of PsWD belonging to Categories A to D and participating in SAMBHAV, Caregivers to PsWD.

## OUTPUT

Report on SAMBHAV 2015 will be published. Video clips of SAMBHAV 2015 will be hosted on social media for wider dissemination. It will include report on the international seminar and performances. SAMBHAV 2014 report has been hosted on our website.

## 10. Financial Implications

Copy of detailed estimates of SAMBHAV 2015 is at Annex. Estimated cost of SAMBHAV 2015 is of the order of Rs.97=00 lakh and involves:

- i. Choreography and production expenses of Indian groups and also round the year production operations by ALPANA Society of the ALPANA Troupe of challenged artists.
- ii. Cost of local and foreign travel, lodging and boarding, local transport of Indian and foreign resource persons/challenged performers with escort. Groups from all continents are being contacted by us. We have formally approached our Ambassadors or High Commissioners in these countries to guide us.
- iii. Accommodation, food, local transport.
- iv. Hosting of the actual events.
- v. Video recording, still photography, invitation etc.
- vi. Costs of publicity, documentation and publication of proceedings of the SAMBHAV 2015.

- ii. Contact Indian Missions abroad, foreign missions in New Delhi etc.

- v. Prepare ALPANA Troupe of Challenged Artists in different centers to present performances in SAMBHAV.
- vi. Approach the Ministry of Culture, Govt of India and the Indian Council of Cultural Relations (ICCR), Ministry of External Affairs, Govt of India to partially support the event.
- vii. Write to several State Governments to send their teams to the event.
- viii. Advance payments for rental of the venues for the event.
- ix. Framework for International Seminar.
- x. Enlist cooperation from key stakeholders.
