Q. What is the process of land acquisition for 400 kV transmission line & tower by the Power Grid corporation of India ltd.

The Transmission Projects in the country are implemented by the licensee in accordance with the provisions of the Electricity Act, 2003. POWERGRID is a designated "Central Transmission Utility" (CTU) under section 38 of the Electricity Act, 2003. Being a CTU, it is also a "Deemed Transmission Licensee" under section 14 of the said Act.

As per the existing provisions of applicable acts/regulations, **land for tower area and Right of Way is not required to be acquired** and only compensation towards damages which are assessed/ reviewed by the Revenue Authorities are to be paid during implementation of such projects. The issues of compensation are governed by Section 67 & 68 of the Electricity Act read with Section 10 & 16 of the Indian Telegraph Act, 1885 as POWERGRID has been vested with the powers of Telegraph Authority vide MOP's Gazette Notification dated 24.12.03 under section 164 of the Electricity Act.
