## Information sought by Sh. Sumit of Ludhiana under the RT! Act, 2005.

The information sought by the requester is general in nature and do not pertain specifically to any transmission line of POWERGRID. However, following may be noted:

- (i) For the detail & Rules, if any for purchase and sale of residential plots near high voltage electricity wire and rules for deal therefore, matter may be taken up by the requester with local administration/revenue authority.
- (ii) There is no impact of high voltage electricity wire on crops, animal and human being living or under shadow of these wires.

It may be informed that the transmission lines in the country are constructed as per the Central Electricity Authority's Regulations 2010/2011 viz. "Technical Standards for Construction of Electrical Plants and Electric Lines", "Measures relating to Safety and Electric Supply" & "Safety requirements for Construction, Operation and Maintenance of Electrical Plants and Electric Lines" as well as Bureau of Indian Standard 1S: 5613. These documents are available in public domain and can be accessed from the web sites/ offices of CEA & GIS. These regulations provide the parameters for various voltage levels of the transmission lines.

CEA's Regulations for "Measures relating to Safety and Electric Supply, 2010" inter-alia stipulate under clause no. 61, that an overhead line shall not cross over an existing building as far as possible and no building shall be constructed under an existing overhead line. Further, in case of an overhead line conductor passing above or adjacent to any building or part of a building, the minimum electrical clearances are stipulated.

Further details in this regard may be sought from the Central Electricity Authority, New Delhi.
