Is Government looks such person from Public at large or its close door decision?	A copy of the criteria laid down by the Government for persons to be considered for appointment as non-official Directors on the Boards of CPSEs is enclosed. The proposals for appointment of non-official Directors on the Boards of CPSEs are initiated by the concerned administrative Ministries. These proposals are considered by the Search Committee and non-official Directors are appointed on the basis of recommendations of Search Committee.
3. How many posts are vacant as of today for appointment of Government appointment director (for all PSUs)? Is there any empanelment for such directorship?	Since this information is available with the CPSEs, a copy of your RTI application has been transferred to all CPSEs to furnishing information as available with them to you directly.
4. As of today government appointed directors of Public Sector Units (for all PSUs) please provide as follows: a. PSU wise appointed director list pending directorship, their tenure of appointment. b. Out of which how many non government servants? c. How many ladies appointed as director out of total nominated directorship? d. How many PSUs not have any ladies director on board as today?
