

Query A	How many candidates applied for the post, category wise
Reply A	Number of Valid Online Registrations for the post of AET(Electronics) through GATE 2017: General - 274, OBC(NCL) - 165, SC - 159, ST - 73
Query B	What is the ratio for interview?
Reply B	As per the process, the candidates are provisionally shortlisted category-wise for GD and Interview in the ratio of 1:5 (for 3 or less vacancies), 15 for 4 vacancies and in the ratio of 1:3 for 5 or more vacancies
Query C	When interview will be conducted, expected date.
Reply C	The requested information pertains to a speculation and does not come under the purview of the RTI Act, 2005.
uery D	How many candidates applied for the post in OBC having GATE score more than or equal to 735(out of 1000) or How many candidates applied for the post in OBC having GATE marks than or equal to 55.92 (out of 100).
- F-7	Reply to the question shall amount to disclosure of the shortlisting status of the requestor (who is also an applicant). However, considering that the process of shortlisting for GD and Interview has not yet commenced, such disclosure shall amount to giving undue advantage to one candidate(i.e. the requestor) and would harm the competitive position of a third party(i.e. other applicants to the post).
	Accordingly, the requested information is denied under clause 8 (d) of The RTI Act, 2005.
