Two years full time Post Graduate Degree/ Diploma/ MBA in HR/ Personnel Management & Industrial Relations/ Social Work (with specialization in Personnel Management & Industrial Relations)/ HRM and Labour Relations/ Labour and Social Welfare from recognized University/ Institute with not less than 60% marks.

(The above specification is also, identical for the post of JOT(HR))

Sir, if I am not wrong, post for HR / Personnel require Master degree in HR/ HRM/ Personnel Management / Labour Welfare etc. which is an ***open-ended qualification.***

In India, there are numbers of educational institution and universities are offering a variety of courses in those discipline. My degree is also coming in that one. Foreign universities awarding MA, MSc, MS, etc. in HR/HRM and such another allied subjects. In India, such as TISS, Jamia Milia Islamia, etc institution offering Master of Arts in HRM.

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

a. Qualification

Two years full time Post Graduate Degree/ Diploma/ MBA in HR/ Personnel Management & Industrial Relations/ Social Work (with specialization in Personnel Management & Industrial Relations)/ HRM and Labour Relations/ Labour and Social Welfare from recognized University/ Institute with not less than 60% marks.

- FG 81** Final Year / Semester students of academic year 2017-18, who expect their results by 31.08.2018 may also be considered eligible, provided they obtain minimum 60% marks or equivalent CGPA in aggregate of all semesters/ years up to pre-final examination at the time of applying for any of the above posts. Their candidature shall be provisional and will be considered for appointment in the event of selection, only if they meet all the eligibility criteria specified.
- FG 81** The percentage of Marks in essential qualification shall be considered without rounding off.
- FG 81** For instruction on conversion of CGPA into percentage, refer to points 6 and 7 of "GENERAL INFORMATION AND INSTRUCTIONS".
- FG 81** Wherever specialization is mentioned, subjects in specialization required should have been part of the examination cleared and find mention in the final mark sheet / degree certificate or the specialization should be certified by the concerned University/ Institute attended / attending by the candidates. Similarly, in case when a candidate claims to have PG Degree/ PG Diploma/ MBA in an equivalent discipline, she/ he shall necessarily have to submit marksheets indicating subjects studied and certificate from the institute. Candidates must have majority of papers from Human Resource Management. - Venue of Test : Candidates are requested to visit the Venue of the Test, a day before the examination so as to reach in time on the day of examination. The request for change of City/Centre of examination/Subject will not be entertained. The candidates are permitted to appear at the allotted venue of test only. No candidate will be allowed to appear in the examination at any other centre of examination other than the allotted center. The candidate should sit on the seat allotted to him/her only.
- Candidates shall have to be present at the examination Centre by 7.00 am (IST) for Paper-I and by 1:30 pm (IST) for Paper-III i.e. atleast 30 minutes before the commencement of the examination. Since the time gap between Paper - I and Paper - II is only 30 minutes no candidate is allowed to leave the examination hall/centre after Paper - I.
- No Candidate, in any case, will be allowed to enter the Examination Centre after the commencement of the examination in each paper.
- The candidate has to appear in the Paper - II & Paper - III in the subject mentioned in the admission card. Change of subject is not allowed.
- Entry to the Examination Hall will not be allowed without this admission card. Candidates should also bring along with them a valid photo ID proof for verification..
- No candidate will be allowed to leave the examination hall/ room before 12:30 P.M. in the 1st session and 4:30 P.M. in the 2nd session.

 - The candidate(s) not following the instructions given by the invigilators in the examination hall and found arguing with the invigilators/other staff involved in the examination duty at the examination centre.
 - The candidate(s) found sitting on the seat other than that seat allotted to him/her, appeared at other centres or appeared in other subject than that mentioned in the admit card.
- The Physically Challenged(PwD) candidates must carry a copy of the disability certificate in the prescribed format of the Govt. of India otherwise the relaxations mentioned at serial no. 9 page 8 of the information bulletin of NET NOVEMBER 2017 will not be provided to him/ her during the examination.

The mere fact that admission card has been issued after online submission of application form and the candidate is allowed to appear in the test shall not imply that the CBSE/UGC has finally accepted his/ her candidature.
