<b>Text of RTI First Appeal :</b>	<p>Respected Sir, 1. I had filed my RTI dt.12.06.18 (PGCIL/R /2018/50408) before your esteemed department but I had received only a belated reply dt.18.06.18 in response to the same. However, upon its perusal, it can be concluded that much of the information has been concealed by your department, including the general information like the current pay-scale, grade, gross salary etc. of the employee concerned, which is contrary to law. 2. It is further submitted that even in my earlier RTI Applications/ 1st Appeals, the valid information sought by me was deliberately concealed in contravention of the law, despite the fact that I had cited applicable case-laws and CIC decisions in my correspondence. Your department had not even divulged the name of the officials ill-advising the CPIO. 3. Even though your department is aware that fortunately or unfortunately, your employee Mrs. Supriya Singh is still my wife as per law, your department has chosen to conceal the information on untenable grounds of invasion of privacy even though I had not even asked for her net salary or</p>		

the salary breakup. You may be aware that even an unrelated citizen is entitled to obtain the information about a public servant which I had sought in my RTI Applications. On the other hand, it is pertinent to note that she has access to your emails as was clearly established by the fact that she possesses my emails sent to you, without having obtained the same through any RTI Application. 4. In view of the above, my fundamental right to information u/Art.19(1)(a) has been gravely violated repeatedly by your department in a wilful manner. Therefore, I request you to provide me the information sought by me, without any further delay, in the right earnest in the spirit of the RTI Act. 5. If the information sought by me is again concealed by your esteemed office, then I shall have no alternative other than to file a Complaint and Appeal before the Honorable CIC and bring all the present and past facts to its notice for taking strict action against the erring officials.
