


## Point wise reply to RTI Query of Sh Kuldeep Singh Cheema is as given below:

- 1. Does POWERGRID follow the guidelines given by Min of Power vide letter no. 3/7/2015-Trans Government of India dated 15 Oct 2015 for erecting transmission lines having capacity 220 kV to 800 kV to give compensation to effected land owners whose land is used by Power Grid. Copy of letter is attached?
  - Ministry of Power guidelines for payment of land compensation towards damages in regard to Right of Way for transmission lines in addition to normal tree and crop compensation dt. 15<sup>th</sup> Oct.'2015 in point No. 4 provides that the guidelines are to be adopted by the respective States/ UTs and appropriate direction/ order have to be issued for its implementation. As per the information available till date, only 13 states viz. Andhra Pradesh, Gujarat, Chhattisgarh, Kerala, Karnataka, Madhya Pradesh, Maharashtra, Assam, Odisha, Tamil Nadu, Jharkhand, Sikkim and Manipur have adopted MoP guidelines and hence, compensation is paid for the transmission lines being constructed in these states as per the provisions of the said guidelines/ State Govt orders/ directions.
- Does Power Grid pay compensation to land owners @ rate of 85% of collector rate of land value under tower points and 15% of collector rate of land value under the RoW area for foundation, erection, stringing transmission lines having capacity 220 kV to 800 kV.
  - ➤ As already explained above, land compensation for tower base and corridor as per MoP guidelines/ State Govt orders/ directions is paid one time and not separately for foundation, erection and stringing in the 13 states mentioned above.
- Does Power Grid pays the compensation for damage to crop and trees separately incurred during erection, foundation and stringing of transmission lines of 220 kV to 800 kV.
  - Yes, POWERGRID pays compensation to the land owners for all damages in crop & trees during foundation, erection and stringing in accordance with provision of Electricity Act, 2003 read with Indian Telegraph Act 1885. As POWERGRID has been entrusted with power under Telegraph Act 1885 vide MoP notification dtd. 24.12.03.
