**ORDER**

**Grounds of Appeal**

The Appellate Authority has received an online Appeal bearing number PGCIL/A/2018/60008 dated 21<sup>st</sup> January, 2018 from Ms. Anita. Earlier, the appellant herein had filed an RTI application bearing number PGCIL/R/2018/50795 dated 9<sup>th</sup> December 2018, under RTI Act, 2005 with the CPIO Corporate Centre, POWERGRID seeking various information regarding POWERGRID's Accelerated Carrier Growth Scheme (ACGS).

Appellant has filed the appeal on account that she has not received the question papers of all the ACGS schemes of POWERGRID till date of filing RTI application for promotion from Supervisor to Engineer (Electrical) and Workman to Supervisor (Electrical).

On receipt of the appeal, information provided to appellant by CPIO vide letter dated 9<sup>th</sup> January 2019, and relevant papers were perused. CPIO informed that all information other than the question papers were provided to the appellant.

## **Decision**

The appellant herein is seeking the question papers of all the ACGS schemes of POWERGRID till date of filing RTI application for promotion from Supervisor to Engineer (Electrical) and Workman to Supervisor (Electrical). I am of the considered opinion that if the information regarding question paper is provided, POWERGRID will no longer be able to use those questions for future recruitment examinations consequently, will dilute the standard of the examination by encouraging cramming. Therefore, in the present scenario, if public disclosure of question is allowed it would compromise the quality of the examination process which is not in line of the object of the RTI Act, 2005. In view of the foregoing the disclosure of information sought cannot be made.

The Appeal is accordingly disposed of.
