

Point wise reply of the queries pertaining to Corporate Contract Services Department is given below:

Query:

1. It is understood that Govt of India, Ministry of Power under Order no 11/05/2018-Coord dated 20th December 2018 has instructed that certain local percentage of procurement is to be ensured to promote the local industry. Please let me know whether PGCIL as PSU is following the order in full compliance in their projects for their procurement for various equipment like Conductor, Insulators, Transformers, Reactors or AIS/GIS substation equipment.
2. Please let me know whether there are any items of procurement where the local procurement is not being ensured.
3. What measure PGCIL is taking so that the order is strictly adhered to in all their projects under bidding including those of Green Energy Corridor projects under RTM and TBCB.

Reply

POWERGRID has implemented Govt. of India, Ministry of Power Order no 11/05/2018-Coord dated 20th December 2018 for all items of procurement covered under the order for domestically funded projects.

In regard to Green Energy Corridor Projects - A, B, C & D of POWERGRID, funded by multi-lateral funding agencies viz., ADB & KfW, it is informed that awarding of various contracts for these projects was completed prior to the aforesaid order.

In regard to TBCB projects, it is informed that the Bid Process Coordinators (BPCs) invite offers/bids for various Transmission System Projects under TBCB route on Global Competitive Bidding basis through two stage bidding process namely Request for Qualification (RfQ) and Request for Proposal (RfP) bidding process. For this participation in RfQ and RfP bidding process, POWERGRID undertakes pre-bid tie up with different contractors.

In the event of emerging as successful bidder, POWERGRID acquires the Special Purpose Vehicle (SPV), mandated for implementation of a particular TBCB Project on Build, Own, Operate and Maintain (BOOM) basis, from the BPC. Upon acquisition, the SPV, which consequently becomes wholly owned subsidiary of POWERGRID, takes up various activities for project implementation including award of contracts for various Packages associated with the TBCB Project which is generally on the contractors with whom pre-bid tie up was made by POWERGRID while participating in the bidding process that the BPC had undertaken.
