

Please provide the copy of communications, meeting details and minutes thereof along with all correspondence between PGCIL and CTU, since 1 June 2018, on transmission projects related to Green Energy Corridor, whether under Regulated Tariff Mechanism or TBCB mode bidding.
- **Reply**: POWERGRID is notified as Central Transmission Utility (CTU) so there is no separate correspondence between POWERGRID & CTU regarding coordination activities of various transmission projects. Moreover since 1 June 2018 there is no transmission projects related to Green Energy Corridor under regulated tariff mechanism or TBCB mode bidding.
- Query 2: We understand that the Ministry of Power has already given the go ahead to start work on Green Energy Corridor under regulated tariff mechanism route. In this regard please provide the copy of communication between PGCIL and Ministry of Power pertaining to Green Energy Corridor projects allocated under regulated tariff mechanism route in the last 6 months.

No transmission scheme pertaining to Green Energy Corridor projects has been allocated to POWERGRID under regulated tariff mechanism route in the last 6 months.
