Please refer to your below reply against our RTI application No. PGCIL/R/2019/50220 Dated 21.05.2019

The grounds of appeal are as under

- 1. There is no clarity in your reply in para 1 that whether written departmental exam has been held or not for candidates having only qualification of diploma in engineering as they were not eligible for promotion as per reply given in para 1.
- 2. There is no clarity whether marks has been given to candidates having qualifications of degree in engg. The answer given by CPIO, PGCIL is misleading. It is being told that CPC evaluates candidates on the basis of their various factors in which qualification is one of the factor. CPC evaluates the candidates on the basis of marks but answer is leading to lot of confusion. The basic purpose was to know that what advantage has been given by CPC in its evaluation to candidates having Degree in Engg in CPC proceeding but answer given is misleading, confusing as per answers given in Para 2 & 4.
- 3. It is being told that no advantage has been given to candidates having higher qualifications of Degree in engg. It is raising question on promotion criteria followed.
- 4. The basic purpose of RTI is being denied, It was **requested 02 times by e mail** on 18.06.19 & 09.07.19 to CPIO, PGCIL to clarify the whole issue but no reply was given.
- 5. It seems that advantage has been given to some candidates having qualification of diploma in engg without holding written deptt. exam due to which information sought is being denied and now misleading answers are being given.
- 6. 15 marks in CPC has played cruical role where it has been decided that whether candidate has been promoted or not promoted.
- 7. The common citizens have the right to know whether suitable officials have been promoted. Larger public interest is involved as officials given promotion have to work on important power assets of our country and mission of developing nation.
- 8. It is important to know whether same criteria has been followed while evaluating the candidates with same qualifications & experience due to which copy of final evaluation sheets desired in para 9 is read

due to reasons mentioned above and common citizen has right to know about it as per provisions of RTI act.

Relief Required through this Appeal:

CPIO, PGCIL may be informed to give following information.

- 1. Para 2& 4 It is being told that no marks has been given for candidates having degree in engg. as compared to candidates with diploma in engg in para 2 whereas in Para 4 it is being told that qualification is one of the criteria while awarding CPC marks. Matter may be clarified as per records of CPC 2019 .. So complete details is given about the qualification benefit for candidates with Degree in engg as per records of CPC 2019 is given.
- **2.** Para 7 –Detailed evaluation criteria followed in giving 15 CPC marks is given with clarification of marks fixed for physical interview, Qualifications, Experience profile & any other factors.
- 3. Para 8 Marks given for performance in physical interview is disclosed.
- 4. Para 9 The object of RTI Act is to empower the citizens and hold the Government accountable to citizens, by providing them access regarding functioning of public authority. The name & employee no of candidates & officials who have dove evaluation is redacted (i.e name and employee no is removed) and if same is removed then there shall not be any violation of 8(1) j and 8(1)e as no name of third party shall be disclosed, So It requested that copy of final evaluation criteria region wise is given.
- 5. Para 10- It has been told that specific request shall be considered but despite 02 emails no reply has been given . So It is requested that following replies are given
- (a) Copy of approved Noting region wise on the basis of which promotion has been given in each region for the promotion of Manager to Chief Manager (E5 to E6).
- (b) Copy of approved Noting on the basis of which condition of degree in engg. has been relaxed for few candidates who have only done diploma in engineering.

The basic purpose of RTI is to assist the citizens expeditiously in giving desired information but despite 02 requests through e mail no reply was given. It is now requested that CPIO, PGCIL may be informed to give above information at earliest.



This condition will be relaxable by CMD only in exceptional cases where knowledge and performance of an individual is adjudged, by a committee duly constituted for this purpose, to be equivalent to a degree in engineering and CMD is satisfied that such relaxation is justified
- 2. Whether any extra marks in CPC 2019 proceedings was provided to officials who have done degree in Engg. as compared to candidates who have done diploma in Engg.

Reply: No

3. Whether qualification details of all the officials due for above promotion were available with Departmental promotion committee during evaluation in CPC proceedings.
