### OFFICE MEMORANDUM

Subject: Customization of provisions of FR 56(j) rules for CPSEs in respect of Periodical Review of employees of CPSEs - inter-Ministerial consultation - regarding.

The undersigned is directed to refer to DFE OM of even no. dated 14th December 2015 wherein all CPSEs were requested to ensure that similar provisions as laid down under FR 55(i) are incorporated in their respective CDA / Service Rules and applemented in the spirit of governmented instructions issued vide DoPT OM No. 25013/01/2013-SatuA-IV dated 11-09-2015. The guidelines highlighted in DoPT OMs are as follows:

(i) The cases of Government servant covered by FR 56(i), FR 56(i), or Rule 48(i) (b) of CCS (Pension) Rules, 1972 should be reviewed six months before far/she attains the age of 50/55 years. In cases covered by FR 56(i) and on completion of 30 years of qualifying service under FR 56(i)/Rule 48 of CCS (Pension) Rules, 1972 as per following calendar:

51 No	Quarter in which review is to be made	Cases of employees who will be attaining the age of 50/55 years or will be completing 30 years of service or 30 years of service qualifying for pension, as the case may be, in the quarter
I	January to Murch	July to September of the same year
2	April to June	October to December of the same year
	July to September	January to March of the next year
4	October to December	April to June of the next year

(ii) If continct of a government employee becomes unbecoming to the public interest or observes the efficiency in public services, the government has an absolute right to compulsorily retire such an employee in public interest.

- (iv) The officer would live by reputation built around him, to an appropriate ease, there may not be sufficient evidence to take punitive disciplinary action of removal from service but his conduct and reputation is such that his continuance in service would be a manage to public service and injurious to public interest.
- (v) Constitution of a "Review Committee" as well as a "Representation Committee".

During GPSEs conclave held on 9th April 2018 it was proposed that CPSEs being the counteercial antities will customize and adopt provisions of FR 56(i) as part of performance management measure.

in this regard, it is proposed that CPSEs may consider In review of their employees to identify non-performers, six manths before employee attains the age of as many or complete 20 years of service followed by 2nd review six months before employee thains the upp of 55 years or complete 30 years of service as the case may be on the base of DoPT on ender.


