This has reference to your RTI request dated 2 July, 2019 for providing information under RTI Act, 2005.



Reply to RTI Query of Sh R K Gupta is as given below:

- a. Guidelines for payment of compensation towards damages in regard to Right of Way for transmission lines has been issued by Gol on 15<sup>th</sup> October 2015 (copy of 1<sup>st</sup> page enclosed for reference). Please specify, in which States/ Union Territories of India, Power Grid Corporation of India Limited adopted this policy for compensation of Trees, Bushes, Crop and Land etc. coming in the clearance belt of ROW on either side of the center line for construction and maintenance of EHV transmission line.

Reply:

- Ministry of Power issued guidelines for payment of compensation towards damages in regard to Right of Way for transmission lines which provides payment of 85% of land value for tower base area and 15% of land value towards diminution of land value in the width of Right of Way (RoW) corridor in addition to normal tree and crop compensation on 15<sup>th</sup> Oct.'2015. **The above guidelines are for determining the compensation towards "damages" as stipulated in section 67 and 68 of the Electricity Act, 2003 read with Section 10 and 16 of Indian Telegraph Act, 1885 which will be in addition to the compensation towards normal crop and tree damages. As per point No. 4 of the said guidelines, the guidelines are to be adopted by the respective States/ UTs and appropriate direction/ order have to be issued for its implementation. As per the information available till date, only 14 states viz. Andhra Pradesh, Gujarat, Chhattisgarh, Kerala, Karnataka, Madhya Pradesh, Maharashtra, Assam, Odisha, Tamil Nadu, Jharkhand, Sikkim, Manipur & Uttar Pradesh (Only for UPPTCL) have adopted MoP guidelines.**
