Subject: Request for Information under the Right to Information Act, 2005

- A. I am making the instant application pursuant to and under the relevant provisions of the Right to Information Act, 2005 as well as the judgment dated 20.03.2018 delivered by the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in the matter of Common Cause v. High Court of at Allahabad & Anr., being Writ Petition (Civil) No. 194/2012, wherein the Hon'ble Supreme Court has laid down the guidelines vis-a-vis the Right to Information.
- B. Keeping in mind the various reliefs/ benefits for the State Power utilities as announced by the Ministry of Power-Government of India, I hereby seek the following information from your good self:
- i. Whether the Transmission Charges recoverable from the Uttarakhand Power Corporation Limited (**UPCL**) has been waived off or any rebate in such Fixed/ Demand charges has



- been granted to UPCL for the period of lockdown (i.e. March 2020 to May 2020) due to Covid-19 pandemic?
- ii. What is the quantum of rebate in charges granted to UPCL for the period of lockdown (i.e. March 2020 to May 2020) due to Covid-19 pandemic?
 - iii. Whether the Late Payment Surcharge applicable upon delay in payment of bills for the electricity supplied to UPCL during the period of March 2020 to May 2020 has been waived off?
 - iv. If any of the query above queries in is affirmative, then copy of the Government Order/ Notification or any other Relevant Document issued in this regard may kindly be provided to me.
- C. Please take note that I have deposited the requisite fees of Rs. 10/- through online payment mode.
- D. That I am 'Citizen' of India and I am asking the information as a 'Citizen'.
- E. I assure that I shall not allow/ cause to use/ pass/share/display/ or circulate the information received in any case and under any circumstances, with any person or in any manner which would be detrimental to the Unity and Sovereignty or against the Interest of India.
- F. I also state that the information sought by me is not exempted from disclosure under relevant law in force.
