

1 and 2	<p><b>1.</b> It is understood that a transmission licensee is bound to have insurance with respect to the transmission project executed by it, as per the terms of Transmission Service agreement (TSA), extract of which is as follows:</p> <p><b>9 INSURANCES</b></p> <p><b>9.1 insurance:</b></p> <p>9.1.1 <i>The TSP shall effect and maintain or cause to be effected and maintained during the Construction Period and the Operating Period, Insurances against such risks, with such deductibles and endorsements and co-beneficiary/insured, as may be necessary under</i></p> <p><i>a. any of the Financing Agreements,</i></p> <p><i>b. the Laws, and</i></p> <p><i>c. in accordance with Prudent Utility Practices.</i></p> <p><i>The Insurances shall be taken effective from a date prior to the date of the Financial Closure till the Expiry Date.</i></p> <p><b>9.2 Evidence of Insurance cover:</b></p> <p>9.2.1 <i>The TSP shall furnish to the Lead Long Term Transmission Customer copies of certificates and policies of the Insurances as soon as they are effected and renewed by or on behalf of the TSP from time to time in terms of Article 9.1</i></p> <p><b>2.</b> In regard to above-said, please provide information against Point number 3 to Point number 9 given below. During the construction period, the Insurance is taken by the respective EPC contractor. Thereafter, During operation period, as per Section 10 of Procedure, Terms and Conditions for grant of Transmission license and other related matters Regulations, 2009, Transmission licensee may opt for Self Insurance also.</p> <p>For SPVs of POWERGRID and for RTM projects, Self-Insurance is being adopted as detailed below.</p> <p><i>Self-insurance reserve is created @ 0.12% p.a. on Gross Block of Property, Plant and Equipment as at the end of the year by appropriation of current year profit to mitigate future losses from un-insured risks and for taking care of contingencies in future by procurement of towers and other transmission line materials including strengthening of towers and equipment of AC substation.</i></p> <p><i>The Creation of above reserve is part of Accounting policies of the SPVs and POWERGRID. And as such gets approved as part of approved accounts by the board of the respective companies.</i></p> <p><i>The Board Minutes are commercial confidence documents and therefore disclosure of which are exempted under section 8(1)(d) of RTI Act.</i></p> <p>For RTM projects, TSA is not applicable. Further, as Insurance of SPVs are not covered under third party insurance, no documents are available. Hence, no question of sharing the documents to LTTC arises.</p>
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
