

Point wise reply to RTI Query of Sh Murugasamy is as given below:

1.	Land acquisition act 2013 is applicable for power grid or not. Kindly inform	<p>As regards applicability of provisions of The Right To Fair Compensation And Transparency In Land Acquisition, Rehabilitation And Resettlement (RFCTLARR) Act, 2013, it is to inform that the RFCTLARR Act, 2013 is framed to acquire private land and assets for public purpose replacing the outdated Land Acquisition Act of 1894 which is evident from section 2(l) regarding its applicability.</p> <p>Quote:</p> <p><i>"The provisions of this Act relating to land acquisition, compensation, rehabilitation and resettlement, shall apply, when the appropriate Government acquires land for its own use, hold and control, including for Public Sector Undertakings and for public purpose."</i></p> <p>Unquote</p> <p>Since no acquisition of land is involved in Transmission projects, the provisions of the Act are not applicable for transmission lines. However, in case of Substation land, where acquisition of land is involved, the provisions of RFCTLARR Act, 2013 may be applicable if invoked.</p>
2.	Who is authority according to Section 64 of land acquisition act 2013?	'Authority' mentioned in Section 64 of RFCTLARR Act, 2013, refers to 'Land Acquisition and Rehabilitation and Resettlement Authority' established under Section 51 of the Act.
