Dear Shri Rais Ahmed,

This has reference to the coordination meeting convened by the Deputy Commissioner, Dharwad on 22<sup>nd</sup> May 2018. One of items of Agenda was about relocating 400 KV lines along with the transmission line towers in the permanent campus (Chikkamaligawad) of IIT. A copy of the OM dated 6th June 2016 issued by MHRD, Govt. of India in this connection is enclosed.

We are now making a formal request to PGCIL to work out the estimate and also relocating plan of HT lines as mentioned in the above. As suggested in the OM of MHRD dated 26<sup>th</sup> June 2016, PGCIL may use the land available inside and adjacent to compound wall of IIT to relocate the transmission line tower system. However, we request you to make sure that placement of these towers do not obstruct our functional usage. IIT will bear the necessary charges as estimated following Government guidelines by PGCIL.

#### OFFICE MEMORANDUM

### Subject: Establishment of an IIT in the State of Karnataka

In supersession to this Ministry's letter of even number dated 9th September, 2016 regarding establishment of an IIT in the State of Karnataka and in pursuance of the recommendations of the Site Selection Committee (SSC) and with the approval of the competent authority, it has been decided that Indian Institute of Technology (IIT) in the State of Karnataka will now be set up at a site measuring about 470.21 acres, 1.2 km inside the main road in Kelagari village, Dharwad, with the following conditions:-

- The 220KV and 400 KV HT lines passing through the land should be shifted out of this site (or could be relocated on the periphery of this site).
- ii) A compound wall enclosing the entire land, including the reserve forest land, to be constructed by the State Government, cost of which will be met by the IIT.
- iii) A separate access to be provided from the north-eastern side through Karnataka Housing Board layout to the site for easy access to services by the students, at the cost of the State Government.
- Further, with regard to the suggestions made by the Site Selection Committee while reviewing the progress in preparing the temporary campus at WALMI, Dharwad, necessary steps may be taken to:-
  - Erect the electricity transformer as per the requirement of temporary campus of
  - Repair of 10 staff quarters by the State Government, the cost of which will be met by IIT-Bombay.
- This issues with the approval of the competent authority.
