

Concerning Advt. No. CC/08/2022 Date: 09th December 2022, I want to ask the following questions under RTI Act-2005:-

1- The examination of DT (Electrical) was held on 05.05.2023, In Part-II out of 50 questions 15 questions of general knowledge were out-of-syllabus. Why these 15 questions of General Knowledge were introduced to aspirants without prior information?

2- As per the qualifying criteria of UR /EWS Vacancies, students need Minimum 30% marks (15) in each part. Although in Part-II 30 % (15) questions (General Knowledge) were out-of-syllabus. So now students have only 70% questions (35), out of these 70% of questions (35 questions) a student needs minimum 15 marks which is around 42.86%. Will PGCIL cancel these out-of-syllabus questions of General Knowledge or give some relaxation to the students?

3- How does PGCIL analyze students' results as there may be differences in difficulty level of different shift's question papers?
