In the Connectivity application form, there is provision of details of nearest substation (in case information is available). However, the details of nearest substation mentioned in application form is indicative in nature and Connectivity is granted at a particular substation based on system studies considering proximity of location, availability of margin, bays etc. after deliberations in the meeting with all stakeholders. Further, the list of applicants granted Connectivity including the sub-station at which Connectivity has been granted is available on CTU website
