Seeking information under RTI Act 2005 on behalf of my client for price of felling /cutting down 145 Nos. most valuable teak trees, which are under the corridor of the 400KV D/C Rajarhat-Purnea Transmission line under PGCIL for the company's interest.

Sir,

Under instruction from and on behalf of my above-named client I want to draw your kind attention that my client is an agriculturist by profession and have very small land in plot No. 159, Khatian No. 3536, J.L. No.



148, Mouza Parbatipur, having an area of 1.26 acres. District Nadia. My client planted the most valuable trees not for his crazy hobby, but for my client's family and other dependent members' future financial security point of view. There were about 1000 valuable teak trees standing on the land of my client. By nursing and cultivating said trees and after maturity by selling the woods, my client fulfills all the needs of his family on any emergency situation. By nature of all these trees yield their results after 10 to 15 years, when its growth and market value protect the investment and others securities of my client along with profit. These plants grow with two leaves in the beginning and becomes mature after a handsome period of time. If someone cut down the said trees in the beginning or within 7-10 years it would only be a total damage, not more than this. Despite my client's huge loss in capital investment for planting and nursing of the said 584 most valuable trees which is the only investment for his and his family's future financial security. My client was ruined due to felling down said 584 teak trees in order to drawing high voltage 400 K.V transmission line over my client's said property as advised by the authority concerned. Now once again a notice has been issued to cut down another 154 trees of my client. In this backdrop I hereby issue this letter for taking information as under:

- 1. Kindly inform the details of the proper justification for not considering the required line clearance during the time of construction of the 400 KV transmission line.
  - Reason: Before cutting the said most valuable teak trees in the year 2019, experts from your end have been visited and proper survey took place. But in your above referred letter it is furnished that during patrolling it is observed that many numbers of trees are falling under the line corridor.
- 2. Please inform the substantial compensation along with calculation sheet on the basis of which payment already disbursed for 584 nos. trees in the year 2019? Also inform the proposed/offered compensation along

with calculation sheet to my client for 145 nos. trees for the current year i.e., 2023? Please send a copy of said proposed payment as of today.

Reason: You have mentioned in your above referred letter, that there is no difference in the compensation payment between the year 2016 and the current year i.e., 2023, but practically due to different modes of calculation it has been a huge loss of my client in payment.

- 3. Please inform the reasons for such huge low offer of payment of the aforesaid most valuable and costly trees which have already been cut down i.e., 584 nos. trees, in the year 2019 and which you recently marked to cut i.e., 145 nos. trees.
  - Reason: The measurement of trees during by two spells of time i.e., in the year 2016 and current year i.e., 2023 ought to be abruptly different. But the offer of payment as my client came to know from reliable source is unthinkably lower than the previous one.
- 4. Please inform for not taking adequate precaution before considering the required line clearance during the time of construction and also commissioned the line before proper safety check as you mentioned in your above referred letter?

Reason:In the above referred letter authority concerned gave threat thatthe removal of the trees falling under the line corridor is utmost importance to avoid any untoward incident or fatal accidents.

The information as sought for is not barred by the Act itself nor it is any third-party information.
