INSTRUCTIONS TO CANDIDATES

- The test is of 170 Objective Type questions and duration of the test will be 120 minutes. This Admit Card does not constitute an offer of employment.
- This test is being held in Computer Based mode only.
- This Admit Card is valid only for the test date and shift time as specified thereon. Any request for change of test date or test centre will not be entertained.
- Discrepancies, if any, regarding candidate's particulars in this admit card can be pointed out and emailed at nerts_recruitment@powergrid.in not later than 9 August 2023.
- Candidates are advised to locate their test centre and its accessibility at least a day before the test so that they can reach
 the centre on time on the day of the test.
- Candidates should report at the test centre at least 1 hour before commencement of examination time indicated in the Admit Card so as to complete formalities such as identity verification, collection of documents, instructions etc. Indulging in any malpractice/unfair means in the Examination Hall will lead to disqualification.
- Printed copy of this admit card must be carried to the test centre as entry will not be permitted without the same.
- If Admit Card does not bear the photograph of the candidate, he/she is required to bring one passport size photograph at the time of written test.
- Issuance of the Admit Card does not mean that the candidate has been declared to be eligible. The candidates are being provisionally permitted to appear for the Objective Type Test as per the schedule given on Page-1. The admission at all stages will be subject to his/her satisfying all the eligibility conditions including academic qualification, experience, category, PWD status etc. as mentioned in his/her online application which is subject to verification in the consecutive stages of the selection process or even thereafter against the eligibility criteria prescribed in the advertisement/ notification. If at any stage it is found that the candidate does not fulfill any of the eligibility conditions, his/her candidature shall stand cancelled.
- The candidate must bring any valid original Photo ID such as (i) Voter Card, (ii) PAN Card, (iii) Driving License, (iv) Photo ID Card issued by any government organization, (v) Passport, (vi) Aadhar Card for verification at the test centre; without which candidate will not be permitted for the test.
- Mobile phone, digital/smart watch, bag, handbag, papers, notes, books, calculator, electronic gadgets/equipment, etc. are strictly NOT allowed inside the test centre.
- There shall be no arrangements at the Test Centre for keeping the aforesaid items. If any item is lost, the Test Centre or POWERGRID will not be responsible. COMPUTER BASED TEST INSTRUCTIONS

- Every question is followed by 4 answer options. Choose the option that is most appropriate. Indicate your answer by clicking on the circle / box adjacent to the option you think is right.
- You can go to any question directly by clicking on the question number. The answered question number and the unanswered / skipped question number will appear in different colours.
- If you are doubtful of the answer, you can answer the question and mark a question for review. This will be unmarked automatically, once you come back to the same question at a later time.
- If you want to change your answer to any question, you may select the question and change the answer by clicking on the appropriate answer. In case there is no changes made the previous selected answer will be considered as the final answer.
- Time display at the top of the screen indicates the time throughout the test. The test closes automatically once the allotted time of 120 minutes is over.
- In case you finish your test before allotted time, you will get a confirmation page which will give you two options. Either to go
 back to the test or to complete the test.
- Candidate can submit their exam only after completion 115 minutes from start time of exam.
- In case you want to review the answers in the remaining time you can do so, else, you may complete the test and submit.
- Ensure that you click on submit as a sign on completion. Please be sure before clicking 'Submit' that you have completed the test. Once you submit, you will not be able to go back to the test.
