**ORDER**

The Appellant **Shri Rajeev, D-47, New Colony Bangalore, Pin- 560067** vide his Online RTI Application Registration No.PGCIL/R/E/22/00272 Dt.07.08.2022 had requested for furnishing information under the provisions of Right to Information Act, 2005. CPIO, NR-I has provided most of the information sought by the applicant through RTIMIS Portal on 29.08.2022 except part information i.e. 'Names of Executives' was denied under section 8(1) (g) and (j) of RTI Act-2005.

Point-wise information provided by CPIO, POWERGRID, NR-I on 29.08.2022 through RTIMIS Portal are as below:

Point No.	Contents of information sought	Information provided by POWERGRID
1.	I want to know that transfer policy guidelines are followed in Power grid Northern region 1 or not. I would like to know that how long an executive can stay in the same region as per transfer policy. Further how many executives (with their names) are working in Northern region 1 for 10 years or more.	Transfer policy guidelines are followed and is being implemented in POWERGRID, Northern Region-I in a phased manner depending on work requirements. As on date, 100no. of executives are working in NR-I for 10 years or more. Names of the executives cannot be provided in light of Section 8(1)(g) and (j) of RTI Act, 2005.
2.	As per transfer policy clause 5.8.4 executive must complete atleast one tenure of difficult postings before being promoted to E7 Grade. In this regard I would like to know about following stations/offices of Northern region 1 power grid that how many executives (with names) in E 6 grade are there in following stations/offices who have not completed there tenure of difficult posting and can be considered for promotion to E7 grade in upcoming 2 years: - Faridabad Headquarter	No. of executives in E6 grade who are there in following stations/offices who have not completed their tenure of difficult posting and are due for promotion to E7 grade in upcoming 2 years are: -Faridabad Headquarter- 13(Thirteen) -Jaipur Station- 0 (Zero) -Ajmer Station-01 (One) -Chittorgarh Station- 0(Zero) -Bhiwadi Station- 02(Two)

	- Jaipur Station - Ajmer Station -Chittorgarh Station And -Bhiwadi Station	Names of the Executives cannot be provided in light of Section 8(1) (g) and (j) of the RTI Act, 2005.
3.	If there are any no. of executives in answer to point no. 2. What is the reason behind not transferring them to difficult posting till date. Further when organization shall plan to transfer them, so as to effectively implement transfer policy clause 5.8.4.	The transfers of executives as mentioned at Point No.2 as per the guidelines of POWERGRID Transfer Policy is being contemplated and implemented depending on work requirements in the Region.

Now, first Online RTI Appeal vide Registration No.PGCIL/A/E/22/00041 Dt.07.09.2022 u/s 19(1) of the RTI Act, 2005 has been filed by Appellant Shri Rajeev. In his appeal, the appellant has mentioned that the *information provided is Incomplete, Misleading and False Information because how long an executive can stay in the same Region not answered. The appellant has mentioned he is not satisfied with the information provided to Point No.2 of his RTI application and he has sought exact reason for not implementing transfer policy effectively.*

On going through the contents of Online RTI Application dt.07.08.2022, Appeal Dt.07.09.2022 and subsequently the submission of CPIO, POWERGRID, NR-I on the basis of input received from the concerned Department has been heard. Further the contents of Appeal Dt.07.09.2022 has again been forwarded to CPIO, POWERGRID, NR-I and directed to look into the matter again and take the opinion of the concerned Department as per the provisions of RTI Act, 2005. Accordingly, the concerned Department has further informed that POWERGRID Transfer Policy Guidelines specifies the duration of posting of executives at one location and other information desired in RTI application Dt.07.08.2022 has already been furnished as per the provisions of RTI Act-2005.

Now, on going through the above discussion, it is concluded that the information desired by you and the information which can be provided under the provisions of RTI Act has already been provided. Hence, the appeal is disposed-off.
