In your letter dated 10/01/2023 addressed to Sh. Sushil Mangal, Ref No. NR1/PASTL/TW02/178/4, in para 7, you have referred to Tiron Dimari and 516 Ors. vs. Powergrid & 4 others, W.P.(C) 7005/2015. You have differentiated the project under reference from that case on the ground that the State of Assam had notified its own Guidelines on 10/03/2017.</p> <p>A. Please inform whether the said guidelines of Assam Government were notified before the judgment of the Honorable Gauhati High Court was pronounced.</p> <p>B. Please inform whether PGCIL, in its submissions before the Honorable Gauhati High Court, had relied upon the Assam Government guidelines or referred to them.</p> <p>C. Please inform whether PGCIL, stated before the Honorable Gauhati High Court, that it would grant the compensation as per the Central Government Guidelines only if Assam Government notified its own guidelines.</p> <p>2. Whether PGCIL has, in any such inter-state Project provided compensation to the landowners, in accordance with the Central Government Guidelines where there were no corresponding guidelines by the State Government? If</p>		

yes, please provide the details.

OR

Whether PGCIL has not provided compensation to the landowners even in a single case all throughout India, as per the Central Government Guidelines, if no corresponding guidelines have been notified by the State Governments?

3. Whether PGCIL, in cases where the landholders have approached the High Courts for a grant of compensation as per the Central Government Guidelines, taken a stand before the High Courts that the existence of corresponding state government guidelines is indispensable for providing compensation as per Central Government Guidelines?

4. Whether, in the project under reference, any compensation has been provided to the landholders in Uttar Pradesh, Uttarakhand and other states where the Project is being executed, as per the Central Government Guidelines under reference?

5. Whether the Central Government Guidelines under reference or any other law require that such Guidelines shall be applicable only when there exist corresponding guidelines by the State Government also?

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
