<b>Information Sought :</b>	<p>Subject: Requesting the information as per Right To Information (RTI) Act 2005</p> <p>Dear Sir/Madam,</p> <p>I, Srinivasa Rao Gandham Elder s/o Gandham Gopaiah, working as a project lead in IBM India pvt ltd. I am sending this email on behalf of my father Gandham Gopaiah and my younger brother Gandham Rambabu. I Gandham Gopaiah, S/o. Krishnaiah, aged 75 years and my younger son Gandham Rambabu aged 34 years, R/o.</p>		

Door No. 4-221, Ravipadu Village, Narasaraopet Mandal, Guntur District, is the owner of land admeasuring Ac.3.45 cents in two separate Sy. No. 1/6A3, Ac.2.00 and Sy.No. 1/7/E & 1/7/A, extent Ac.1.45 cents. The land is presently being used for agricultural purposes for which I am eking out my livelihood.

Both State government and central government has approved to merge my village Ravipadu into Narasaraopet municipality in 1993 with G.O.M.S. No.489 M.A. dated 7-8-93. It is submitted that the Government of India in its Master Plan for Narasaraopet has clearly demarcated that my land as stated herein above shall come within the Municipal limits of Narasaraopet which is being transformed into a Municipality. Such being the case, since a transmission tower as well as high transmission lines are passing through middle of my land, I shall not be in a position to make any construction on the said land once Narasaraopet is converted into a Municipality and my land shall fall within the said Municipality. In other words, my land shall become useless for the purpose for which I intend to use it solely on the account of the fact of the transmission tower and the transmission lines passing through the said property on account of which no construction can take place on the said property. The owner of the land furthermore, in a given situation may lose his substantive right to use the property for the purpose for which the same was meant to be used. Narasaraopet has high potential to become a district head courter if state government creates new districts in Andhra Pradesh. Central Government approved national highway between AP/Telangana border to Vodarevu via Narasaraopet in 2014 and allotted number 167A.
