

The details are collected when any tree/ crop is damaged or after completion of the construction work for assessing ex-gratia payment to be paid as per Govt. Order. As such we do not have data/ information with us to give in this regard.

Sometimes detailed survey and check survey are repeated to verify different aspects like developments after initial detailed survey etc.
