No 1.	Details of land compensation paid during 2005-2014(for all lines constructed) .From which year compensation payment started and why not earlier? Details of information required line and tower wise in CD	Transmission line construction is governed by the provisions of the Electricity Act 2003 and the Indian Telegraph Act 1885. As per the Indian Telegraph Act clause 10(b), POWERGRID does not acquire land for transmission line construction and only having user rights on the property under, over, along, across, in or upon which the transmission line is established/maintained. Hence for transmission line construction, land compensation is not paid to land owners. Only compensation towards tree/crop damages and towards other damages, if any, occurred to land owners during the transmission line construction, as directed/ assessed by state/district revenue authorities are
2	Under what clause of Indian Electricity Act, compensation is paid, whether officer order is	paid to the land owners in line with the provisions of the Indian Telegraph Act 1885 clause 10(d).
