PGCIL/R/2019 /50460	<p>1) The issuance of notification is not required under the Electricity Act, 2003 and Indian Telegraph Act, 1885. However, paper publication issued on 20.05.2016 in local dailies "The New Indian Express" and "Dinamani" for the purpose of indicating the proposed route alignment which is only indicative in nature informing the public about the proposed project and the Districts through which the transmission Lines may pass, but the details of the landowners is known only after the marking of tower locations/positions in the field as per the technical requirement &amp; feasibility from the Revenue Authorities.</p> <p>2) The Techno-economically feasible Route has been finalised and approved by the Competent Authority concerned approving authority and it is being implemented. The information sought by the petitioner is technical documents and need not be shared, particularly in view of the fact that the Hon'ble High Court of Madras has perused the records &amp; was satisfied and the procedure adopted by POWERGRID with regard to laying of Transmission Lines/ Towers has been recorded in its Order in W.A. No. 79 of 2019, with the finding that there is no malice in law or in facts and POWERGRID is performing its Statutory duty and the same has been confirmed by the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India.</p> <p>3) The SF no. 121,131,192 situated at Vavipalayam village, Palladam Taluk are identified in the line route of 400 kV Pugalur-Edayarpalayam line, however the same has to be confirmed by State officials for identifying survey nos.</p> <p>(4, 5 &amp; 6) The Techno economic Route has been finalized and approved by the concerned approving authority and it is being implemented.</p> <p>(7, 8 &amp; 9) Required clearance as specified in the Central Electricity Authority (Measures relating to Safety and Electric supply), Regulation, 2010 are being adhered to by POWERGRID and shall be adhered to, by the concerned landowners.</p>
