This has reference to your online application vide Ref. No. POWER/R/P/20/00124 dated 14/05/2020 which is transferred from Ministry of Power to this office as per Sec 6(3) of the RTI Act, 2005 on 22/05/2020. The information sought for in the above application is very generic and vague. However, the query wise reply is furnished below keeping up the spirit of RTI Act, 2005.

Reply to Q.No.1 : POWERGRID has “USER RIGHT” only over the land on which Tower is erected and no acquisition of land is involved in the process. Compensation is paid to the affected land owner for the damages, if any, caused and towards land component based on the assessment and valuation of the concerned departments and District Administration of the States.


Reply to Q.No.2 & 3 : The compensation to Crop/Tree etc. and land component are on the basis of assessment of the respective State Government Departments in terms of Government of India and State Guidelines.
