

Appeal dated 09.08.2021 by Vaghji Ratanshi Ahir in regard to the RTI Application dated 27.06.2021 under Right to Information Act, 2005 ("Act")

ORDER

RTI appeal having no. PGCIL/A/E/21/00031 dated 09.08.2021 had been received through online from the appellant in view of the non-receipt of the Reply/Information in RTI Application dated 27.06.2021, wherein the Appellant had sought for the details as regards to the Mundra- Palanpur (Mundra- Bhuj), Kotda- Palanpur (Bhuj-II- Bhuj) TL.


On perusal of the RTI Application, it is observed that the applicant Sri Vaghji Ratanshi Ahir has applied for name of village, land survey number (where transmission line passes), beneficial farmer name, paid amount to each farmer, pending amount, reason of pending amount of above mentioned lines vide RTI Application dated 27.06.2021 and the Appeal has been preferred by the Appellant on being aggrieved by the reason that no reply/information has been received by the Applicant within the stipulated time from the CPIO.

The First Appellate Authority has found that the CPIO has disposed of the "RTI Application" on merit vide reply dated 16.08.2021, however with a delay in furnishing the reply to the application in time. As the reply has been given on merit, the Appellate authority found no reason to interfere with it. The CPIO is advised to avoid any such delays in future and also cautioned to adhere to the strict compliance of the provisions of the RTI, Act 2005.

On the above grounds, I do not find any reason to interfere with the RTI Reply and the "Appeal" filed by the "appellant" does not hold good and is liable to be rejected. With this order, the Appeal stands disposed of.
