However, a blatant attempt of misleading can be seen in the questions 5 and 6 by the CPIO. Never saw such blind citation of section 8 (1) (d) for such questions. The number of employees in cadres requested doesn't reveal any personal information and NOT EVEN 1 SECTION OR CLAUSE bars CPIO from giving the information sought in the question number 5. And I hereby remind the CPIO that it is not PVT. company, it is a public limited enterprise and it is my RIGHT to know the expenditure that is being made for the payment of their salaries. Urging appellate authority to direct the CPIO in providing the information sought in q. no. 5 and 6 and also I advise you to please direct the CPIO to undergo a refresher course of understanding RTI Act, 2005. Also remind them that year should be mentioned wherever an Act is displayed.</p>
