Sub Appeal

Please refer CPIO letter dt 25-8-2015 (copy enclosed) , wherein it is stated that data is quite voluminous , which would require disproportionate diversion of resources. Further that I can inspect the records at WRLDC office.

I submit following points for appeal.

1 In previous instances similar information was requested for and supplied by CPIO by putting it in website. Last such data was supplied against Query 14 as per WRLDC Website. The information now being requested is of similar type and volume/quantum as in case of earlier instances of data supplied by WRLDC.

2 The data requested for is of SEM meters at Sasan which is already available in electronic /computerised form at WRLDC. This data is supplied along with data of main/check meters from the location. While the data required for energy accounting is processed the other data , ie of unit 765 kV side Sem meters , remains available in the WRLDC computers.

3 Process of retrieving/supplying data already stored in computers would not require disproportionate diversion of resources as it is in electronic/digital form and not the type of data on written log sheets or registers.

4 The data put on website of WRLDC website against previous query/queries has a size of about 400kb for one month. The data for 3 months would be around 1.2 Mb , which is not voluminous.

5 Retrieving/supplying the RTI data would in no way be detrimental to the safety or preservation of record.

6 Since I am a senior citizen (retired SE of PSEB) settled/residing in Patiala , Punjab, the inspection/collection of data at WRLDC Mumbai would be cumbersome.

I appeal that the information may please be supplied in any convenient/feasible manner suitable to WRLDC
